


Returning your Design Kit


First ensure you have all design templates back from each class with the pupils name and class name clearly legible at the top. Place each class into a separate envelope with the class name and number of pupils.

Ideally order these from youngest class to oldest when putting back in the box to return.


Sign into Class Hub www.myfundraisinghub.com




Click 'Manage' on the Fundraising projects tile.




Complete step 1 confirming your school name and that you are returning the kits to us all in one consignment




In step 2 you need to add the total number of classes and total number of artists so if you have 5 classes of 20 pupils then you should input **5** and **100** in these fields.



In step 3 add your class names selecting new class and typing in the class name (Please note that this is what will print on products and appear in the parents ordering portal so these need to be accurate using capital letters correctly etc....) Then input the quantity in each class envelope and the total should match the number of artists you entered at stage 2



In step 4 you need to write the return code on the Royal Mail return label we have provided in the class pack and confirm all is correct before completing your return.



You will then see a success screen and it's a case of packing up your templates and posting them back to us.
