Do not sit or stand on the furniture.

Do not place hot or wet objects directly on the surface of the furniture.

Do not expose furniture to direct sunlight.

Furniture should be used in rooms where the temperature is from 15°C to 30°C, and the air humidity is in the range of 40% to 70%. Furnitureshould not be placed less than one meter from active heat sources.

Furniture should be cleaned with a dry, soft, and clean cloth. Before applying a cleaning agent, always pre-test it on an inconspicuous area on the furniture surface.

Furniture should not be exposed to prolonged contact with water or other liquids. Any spilled liquids should be removed immediately.

Surfaces of oiled furniture should be regularly maintained using care products for oiled furniture, adhering strictly to the producer's instructions.

Wooden or cork furniture undergoes a natural aging process as a result of which they can change their color.
