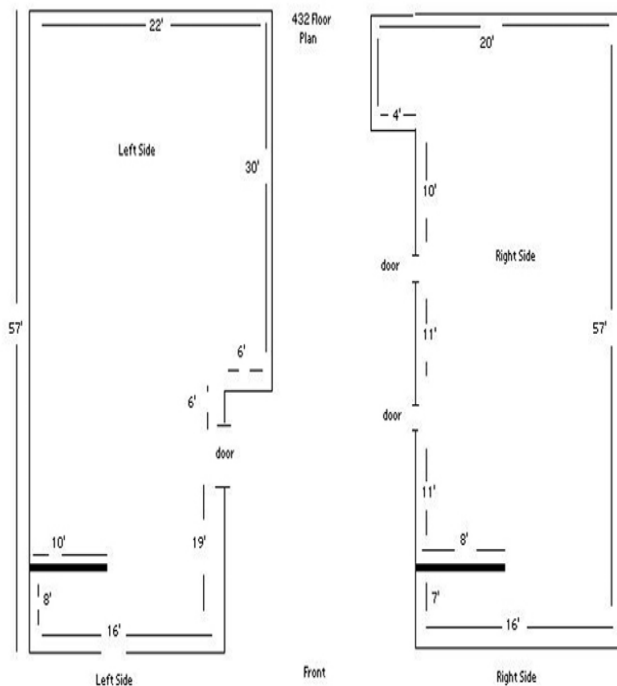
Known as the Yeon Building, 432 Jackson Street dates from 1855 and was the site of the first French Consulate in San Francisco. With its Romanesque arches on the ground level and recessed arches on the second, 432 Jackson Street retains its Romanesque facade.

Balance Street, intersecting Jackson Street, was named for the Gold Rush ship *Balance*, which, like many ships in the early 19th century found herself stranded at what was the original San Francisco wharf, as the city began to expand.
