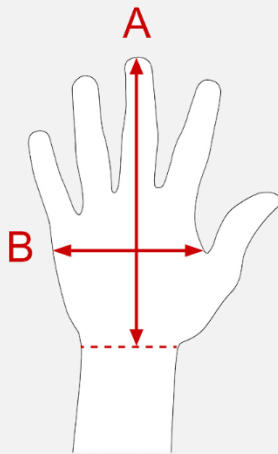

# Gloves



## How to take the measurements

- A** Measure the length of the hand, from the tip of the middle finger to the wrist.
- B** Measure the circumference around the hand, at its widest point.

## How to choose your size

- 1 Using measurement B, find the matching glove size.
- 2 Your other measurements should be smaller or equal to the values in the column.
- 3 If your A measurements are longer than those of the column, consider a bigger glove size.
