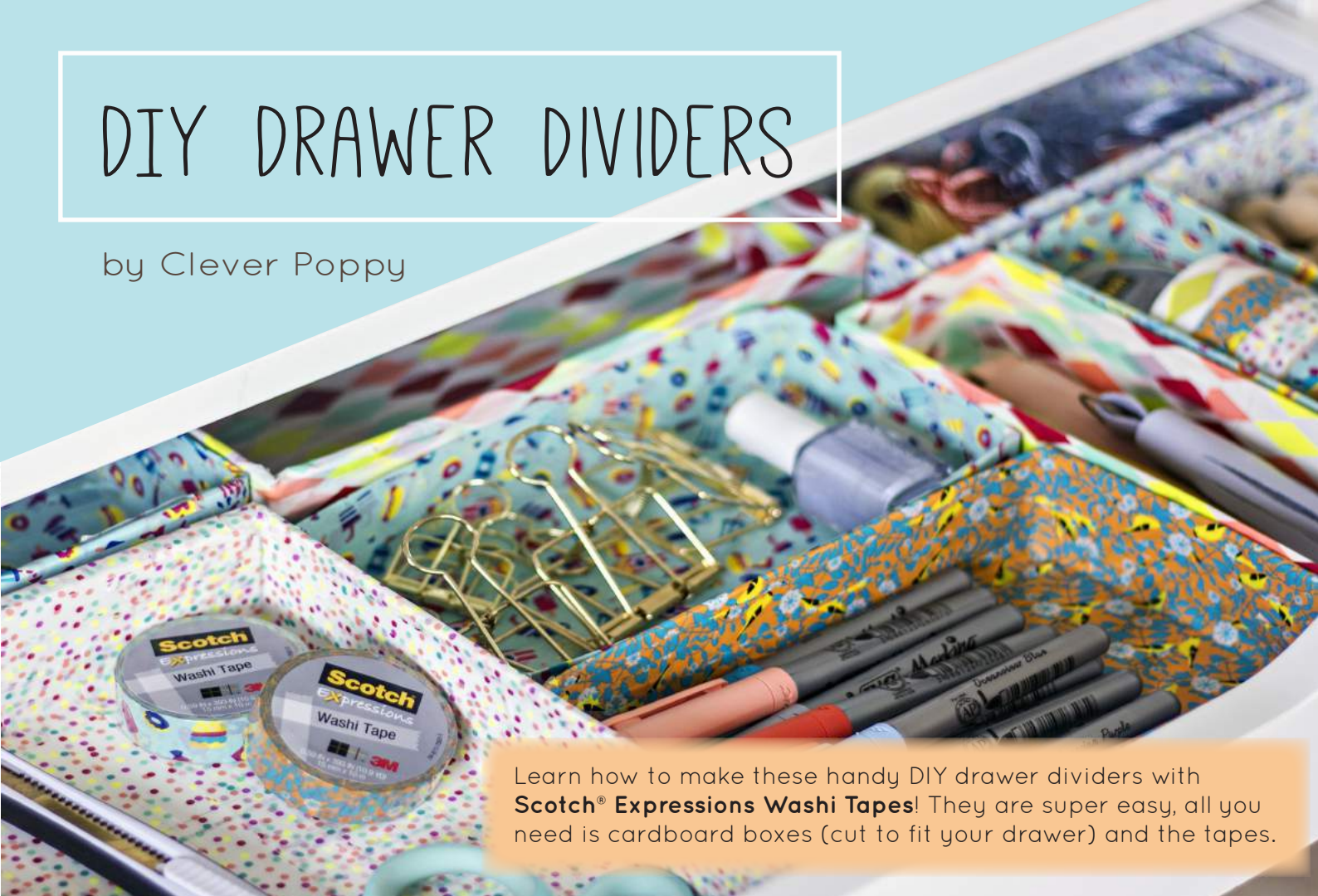


# DIY DRAWER DIVIDERS

Learn how to make these handy DIY drawer dividers with **Scotch® Expressions Washi Tapes!** They are super easy, all you need is cardboard boxes (cut to fit your drawer) and the tapes.

**1 -** Collect cardboard boxes which fit nicely into your drawer, in shapes which suit your stationery. It works best if they fit snugly, you might need to try some different combinations before you get it right. Cut the boxes to the correct height so the drawer can easily open and shut.

**2 -** Now cover the boxes in washi tape. Start on the flat surfaces then fold washi tape along the edges. Cut tiny nicks in the corners so that the tape can easily fold down.



**3 -** Lay out the boxes in your drawer, in the same pattern as you decided in step one. Fill with stationery, and you're done!
