

DIY POP UP XMAS CARDS

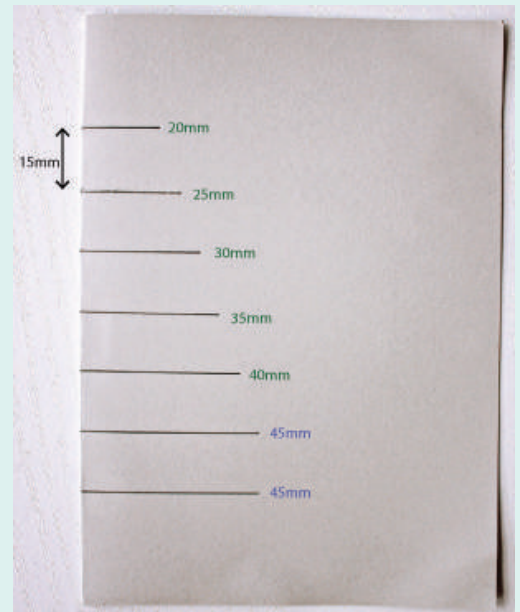


Learn how to make these fun pop up cards this Christmas with **Scotch® Expressions Glitter and Foil Tapes!** You'll also need A4 card, scissors, a pencil, a glue stick and a ruler.

1 - Cut your A4 card in half then fold each piece in half again. Place one of the cards to the side.



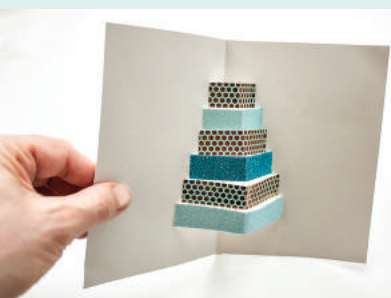
2 - Take the other card and draw lines in a Xmas tree shape, along the folded side. You can use my measurements or freestyle a shape you like.



3 - Cut along the lines through both sides of the card. Then fold each piece of the tree out, making a nice crisp fold at the join.



4 - Open up the card and bend the cut pieces into a tree shape which pops out. Cover the tree folds with the Glitter and Foil Tapes.



5 - Turn over the pop up card and glue around the tree (be careful not to glue the tree folds). Then glue it directly on top of the second piece of card. Use tape to add a trunk and star - then you're all done!
