Lichen Planus Case Report Using StellaLife VEGA Oral Care Gel and Rinse

Description

Two middle age female patients complained of a burning sensation in the mouth and sensitivity in the gum area. After clinical evaluation, a differential diagnosis of Lichen Planus / ELP was considered. A decision was made to perform an incisional Bx.

Method

Patients were placed on VEGA Oral Gel and Rinse course three times daily after the incisional biopsy. The patients were seen 1 week post incisional Bx for a follow-up and re-evaluation.

Results and Conclusion:

On 1 week follow-up appointment, a clinical evaluation revealed significant resolution of the lesions. The patients' symptoms of burning have resolved. One week course of VEGA Gel and Rinse helped to resolve acute presentation of ELP and clinical symptoms of mouth burning. Courtesy of Dr. Walter Tatch
