### **ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**

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- Aloe Vera 0,25%
- Panthenol-D 0,50%
- Sodium hyaluronate 0,25%
- Vitamin E 0,10%

#### **HOW TO USE:**

The cream is for external and internal use.

Apply the gel to fully cover the lesion. If the lesion is difficult to reach, use a clean finger or gauze to help with the application. Avoid touching the area with your tongue for at least 2 minutes to allow the product to stay on the lesion as long as possible.

### **ALOE VERA**
