### PLUMTECH®



PLUMTECH® is a padding created to imitate the fluffiness of down while preserving the advantages of technological thermal lining; it was originally produced from virgin polyester and it's now also available from 100% recycled polyester from used bottles. Compared to traditional down paddings, it absorbs high levels of humidity and dries very quickly. Thanks to the high density of its fibres, it traps an extremely large quantity of air (the best thermal insulation) in its structure, preserving the body's natural temperature and guaranteeing optimal comfort. Our PLUMTECH® is produced under the BLUESIGN® certification, the system guaranteeing sustainable textile production.

Textile Exchange identifies and shares best practices regarding farming, materials, processing, traceability and product end-of-life in order to create positive impacts on water, soil, air, animals, and the human population around the world on behalf of the textile industry.

Textile Exchange provides the knowledge and tools the industry needs to make significant improvements in three core areas: Fibre and Materials, Integrity and Standards, and Supply Network. We have developed several important industry standards, including the Global Recycled Standard (GRS).



The innovative OCEAN IS MY HOME range is created with fabrics made from recovered and recycled fishing nets. The 'we clean the ocean' claim embodies a real commitment not only to recycle materials but also work with and support the Surfrider Foundation Europe. Save the Duck donates part of the proceeds from the sale of every OCEAN IS MY HOME item to the foundation to help clean 300,000 m<sup>2</sup> of beaches, and free oceans and seas from 6,000 kg of rubbish. The garments of the OCEAN IS MY HOME collection are made with a special fabric made from Econyl® 100% regenerated nylon from fishing nets recovered from seas and oceans and recycled post-consumer nylon.
