
Eagles Facts and Trivia: Puzzlers for the Bird-Brained

Preface to the Second Edition

It has been over a decade since I wrote the first edition of this book, and it is time for a new one. Some questions and answers in the first edition became outdated as the history of the team has rolled along in its own quirky fashion. It is time to update our look at the local pro football team that has such a hold on us.



In the Preface to the first edition of Eagles Facts and Trivia, I noted the Eagles' disappointing overall record for their first 73 seasons. Now it's been 84 seasons, and the team still has an overall losing record. Despite attaining 23 winning seasons to just 14 losing ones since 1978, overall the Birds have posted 38 winning years, 41 losers and five at .500. They are still six or seven good seasons away from breaking even in their all-time record.

That's eight entirely new quizzes and four holdovers that have been split into two quizzes each. Essentially, 12 entirely new quizzes. Furthermore, each of the legacy quizzes has at least one new question so that with the 132 new questions for the dozen new quizzes there are roughly 200 new questions in the new edition. Dig in.
