#### Stage 1 and 2 — 6 months+ Baby Trike Stage

The back support can be adjusted to 3 reclining positions. Parents have total control with the adjustable and removable parent push handle. The seat can also be rotated 180 degrees, so your child can face you. This function and the additional footrests are perfect for infants to start using the tricycle. The extra-large canopy has 2 positions and is made of a 50 UPF+ fabric to keep wind and sun at bay.



#### Stage 3 and 4 — 9 months+ Baby Trike Stage

When those little legs get a little longer, it's time to use the flip-down footrest for a little added support and unlock the pedals to ensure you have control of the pace.

#### Stage 5 — 12 months+ Push Stage

Remove the seat pads to encourage your child to start using their own muscles to get comfy, and you're one step closer to letting them ride solo.



#### Stage 6 — 18 months+ Toddler Trike Stage

The additional flip-down footrests are removed. Free wheel function can be engaged to allow kids to place their feet on the pedals without controlling the wheels. Free handle-bar function can also be enabled to allow kids to move the handle bar without steering the trike.





### Stage 7 — 24 months+ Child Trike Stage

It's time to give up some control. The parent handle, the footrests, and the bumper bar are removed to allow children to pedal by themselves.

#### Stage 8 — 36 months+ Classic Trike Stage

The back support, the safety belts, and the basket (optional) are removed for some big kid fun. Take a deep breath, and watch them grow up — they're tougher than you think.
