Aspen Infant & Pediatric Collars

A PROPER FIT AS EASY AS 1-2-3

- 1. Chin-Dots hidden?** The chin must be flush with the front of the chin piece plastic.
- 2. Velcro® past mark?** Back panel plastic must overlap the sides of the front panel.
- 3. FlexTabs™ bent?** The FlexTabs on the front and back panels should be flexed.


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Aspen Cervical Collar Sizing Guide

PICK THE RIGHT SIZE


With the head in the neutral or desired position, place the guide on the highest point of the trapezius and flat against the side of the head.



Sight an imaginary perpendicular line from the bottom of the chin back to the guide and select the proper size collar.

CHECK FOR A GOOD FIT

1. The chin must be flush with the front of the chin piece plastic.
2. The FlexTabs™ on the front and back panels should be flexed.
3. The collar should be "snug" but not touch the tracheal area.
