Contents

1. Important Safety Instructions General Safety

- 1. Please use this humidifier strictly according to the instructions in the user manual to avoid accidents such as fire, electric shock, or 2. This humidifier is suitable for people over 12 years old. Children
- or individuals with sensory disabilities or intellectual disabilities should use it only under the supervision of a guardian. 3. This humidifier is for indoor use only and should be placed on a
- suitable flat surface. Please do not use this humidifier outdoors. 4. Keep the humidifier away from heat sources (e.g., furnaces) and
- 5. This humidifier uses ultrasonic technology to generate mist. It is recommended to use purified or distilled water to avoid residual water stains or white dust in the environment.
- 6. Using the humidifier in small, enclosed spaces or environments with humidity above 70% RH may lead to moisture accumulation
- 7. For nighttime use, it is recommended to turn the humidifier at maximum output 2 hours in advance, then switch to a lower setting before bedtime. In environments with humidity below 40%RH, it is recommended to turn on the maximum setting for humidification.

Operational Safety

- 1. Do not insert or cover any objects into this humidifier to avoid damaging the air inlet and mist outlet, which may cause electric
- 2. Do not immerse the humidifier main unit, power cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- 3. To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use with solid-state speed control devices.
- 4. Do not add essential oils to the water tank or base. This may damage the humidifier and cause leakage.
- 5. When not in use for extended periods, please turn off the humidifier and unplug it from the outlet.

- Electrical Safety
- 1. The input voltage of the humidifier is AC 100-240V 50/60Hz. Please ensure that the voltage meets the requirements before use. 2. If the humidifier is damaged or malfunctions during operation
- please contact customer service or a qualified electrician for repair or replacement. Do not attempt to repair or replace the humidifier 3. Do not touch the power cord or plug with wet hands. The power



- 1. Place the humidifier on a firm, stable, flat, and dry surface. Avoid
- 2. Keep the humidifier away from heat sources (e.g., furnaces) and 3. Place the humidifier at least 1.7 feet away from walls furniture


Preparation before using the humidifier: 1. Remove all packaging, take out and check if all parts: base x 1,

water tank x 1. tank lid x 1, mist outlet x 1, filter x 1. 2. Remove the water tank from the base, take out the sponge


packaging material from the base, clean all parts thoroughly before

the first use, and reinstall the water tank on the base.

Alian the front side of the water tank (marked with **MAX**) with the side of the base that has the control knob. Place the humidifier in a suitable location.



Note: Be sure to install the filter properly. It filters impurities in the water to prevent the valve from being blocked and avoid leakage!



4. Remove the tank, open the tank lid (you can directly add

water into the tank), and avoid the mist tube to add water.

Ensure the water level stays below the MAX line.

3. Find the filter in the box, install the filter to the water tank valve.

Please lift the lid of the tank from here and return it to its place after filling

Important:

- We recommend using purified or distilled water. Tap water may lead to mineral buildup.
- Do not add water directly into the mist tube; this may cause leakage.




5. Reattach the tank lid and reinstall the water tank onto the base



6. Plug in the power cord. Turn the control knob clockwise to select the desired output level.

- When the water tank has sufficient water and is correctly installed on the base after about 30 seconds, turn the knob clockwise. The indicator light will turn green, and when the level indicator line

his humidifier has an "Auto Shut-off" safety feature. If the water runs out or the tank is lifted, the humidifier stops automatically and the red light turns on. After installing a water tank with sufficient water on the base, turn the knob counterclockwise to er to cool down before cleaning. OFF then turn it clockwise again to resume operation.


Precautions:

1. After extended use, it is necessary to clean the water tank and grooves to prevent scale or impurities from blocking the water tank valve and avoid possible malfunctions.

2. To avoid excessive humidity that may cause dampness and water accumulation around the humidifier, please adjust the mist output to a lower level when using it in an enclosed space for

1. Regular cleaning can extend the life of the humidifier. It is recommended to clean the humidifier every 2 to 3 days to remove any slimy film or scale from the water tank and base.

- 2. If the humidifier will not be used for an extended period, be sure to clean the device before long-term storage. 3. Unplug the power cord from the outlet and wait for the humidif
- 4. Do not immerse the base or power cord in water or any liquid.
- 5. Do not use corrosive, dissolving cleaning agents or chemica reagents. Avoid steel wire brushes or other sharp or hard tools that could damage the humidifier.


Water Tank Cleaning:




Base Cleaning:
