

# Using a 1lb Propane Bottle



## Items Required:

- Campfire In A Can
- "Steak Saver" Adapter
- 1lb propane bottle

## Hook Up Procedure:

Step 1. Attach the Steak Saver to the POL on the regulator. Make sure the yellow handle is in the closed position, see photos below.



Step 2. Attach the 1lb propane bottle to the Steak Saver, see photos below.



Step 3. Slowly open the yellow handle gas valve as you hold your lighter to the burner.

A 1lb tank has enough propane for about a 1 hour fire. When your fire starts to go out, and your propane tank is covered with frost, the propane tank is not out of propane! The problem with these tanks is that the air chamber inside the tank, where the liquid propane changes from a liquid to a gas, is very small. The air space gets extremely cold from the changing process. This slows the process down, or can even stop it completely. The tank must be removed and allowed to warm up so it can be used again. I recommend having 3-4 tanks so you can exchange them as needed.
