






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
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## Mixing Cartridge (A107) Directions

		<p>Remove the Blue and Red button.</p> <p>Remember when re-installing that the Blue half goes on the right side.</p>
		
<p>Insert a flat blade screwdriver into the buttonhole (it may take a 2.5mm allen wrench instead). Choose the proper size.</p> <p>Engage the setscrew and loosen a couple of turns – <b>DO NOT REMOVE.</b></p> <p>Remove the faucet handle.</p>		
		<p>Unscrew the silver crown by turning counter-clockwise.</p>
		<p>Unscrew the brass-retaining ring. It's a large size ring – approximately 30mm. A large crescent wrench should be able to grab it.</p>

**NOTE: The following pictures are guidelines – some Keller Mixing Cartridges are different sizes – but ALL are replaced the same way.**

<p><b>K4003, K4009, K4013, K4030 Faucet Barrel Interior</b></p> <p><b>Hot &amp; Cold Water Inlets</b></p>  <p><b>Mixing Cartridge Positioners</b></p>	<p>Remove the defective mixing cartridge.</p> <p>Notice the Faucet Barrel Interior.</p> <p>Install the new mixing cartridge.</p> <p>Use the 2 locator pins on the bottom of the new mixing cartridge to properly position the mixing cartridge inside the faucet barrel.</p>
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<p><b>Set Screw Dimple</b></p> <p><b>KSY Mixing Cartridge</b></p>  <p><b>Top View</b></p> <p><b>Bottom View</b></p> <p><b>Locator Pins</b></p>	<p>Re-assemble the faucet by reversing the disassembly process.</p> <p><b>SPECIAL NOTE:</b> When re-attaching the faucet handle – be sure the handle is positioned with the setscrew dimple in line with the setscrew. Otherwise your faucet handle will not operate the water flow as intended.</p>
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
