

TD-207 UV Hot Towel Warmer Directions



Function:

- This towel warmer is used for heating dry and damp towels, warming cosmetics, storing sterile instruments and accessories (sponges, brushes, napkins, etc.).
- The sterile environment will hold about two-dozen small hand towels (when rolled up) while maintaining a temperature of approximately 158°F (70°C) to 176°F (80°C) depending on the temperature of the room it's in.
- The number, condition and type of towels used will dictate the warm up time.
- Unit has a bottom tray for capturing moisture released from inside the unit empty daily.


NOTE: This Towel Warmer is <u>NOT</u> a Sterilization Unit. It will <u>ONLY</u> maintain a sterile environment (the inside walls) for <u>ALREADY</u> sterilized equipment.

NOTE: Please follow all Local and State regulations regarding sterilization. Additional requirements may be necessary.





- Unit should always be used with the stainless steel basket.
- Load dry or damp clean towels or other items and turn HEAT "ON":
 - o Internal temperature should reach maximum in about five minutes.
 - o Turn all switches to "OFF" when unit is not in use.



- DO NOT place heavy items or bottled liquids on top of the unit which may scratch the enamel paint surface and cause rust.
- DO NOT drop the unit as this may cause the unit to malfunction.
- DO NOT disassemble or attempt to repair this unit.
- DO NOT connect the power cord to an improper outlet.
- DO NOT damage the power cord or bend the power plug prongs.
- DO NOT plug this unit into an outlet with too many other items in the same outlet.
 - o Check the power plug regularly to ensure it is dust free and firmly installed.
- DO NOT submerge this unit it is not waterproof.
- DO NOT use this product outdoors or in a humid environment.
- DO NOT put heavy objects or pressure on the unit's door when opened.
- DO NOT use the unit without the stainless steel basket:
 - During operation, the inner box surface, basket and the door backboard are extremely HOT – CAUTION should be used when adding or removing the towels.
 - Too many towels inside unit may touch the inner box surface which is extremely HOT.
- NEVER leave any towels in the unit at the end of the day:
 - Remove the basket; wipe up any remaining water drops or moisture inside the box or on the basket.
 - o Leaving any moisture in the inner box or on the basket may cause odors.
- REMOVE the drain water tray (under the unit) before it overflows and discard.
