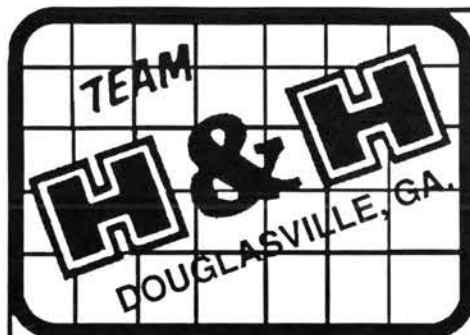

DEER PARK

Hare
Scrambles

The 1991 FTR Hare Scrambles Series started with a bang at the Deer Park Race located in the sleepy laid back community of Deer Park. Championship Motorsports Racing Association had done much work to promote this event and were glad to see a huge crowd of better than 425 riders enter the weekends activities. The property owners had a good ole fashion BBQ dinner and sold almost 100 plates. If you missed it, it was goooood!

The work started about six weeks prior to the event date with new, unfamiliar land. The 10,000 plus acres of land to be used for the Hare Scrambles had never been traversed by motorcycles (affectionately referred to by locals as "Bad Boy Bikes"). The land owner opted to show us the property which he knew like the back of his hand, (very frustrating for me). After a few weekends in the woods, things started looking pretty good. With completion in sight and close to thirteen miles of course pre-arrowed, things were going good. Well, open mouth insert foot - the RAIN came, then more rain, and yes, MORE RAIN. Well after another weekend of routing and rerouting, then came the rain AGAIN. We were down to two work weekends before the race and all we had to show for all our hard work was a beautifully arrowed 12.9 mile course... did I mention it was totally underwater?

The landowner, feeling pretty sorry for use about now, suggested an alternate portion of his land. We were pretty comfortable with what needed to happen now. More staples, more arrows, more palmettos. With hard work and dedication, a new 13.0 mile course quickly appeared and Round 1 of the 1991/92 FTR Hare Scrambles season began.

At the riders meeting it was announced that this would be the first race on the new Yamaha YZ Contingency Program and that Renthal would be helping out at this event with contingencies for winners using Renthal products.

First Race.

The ten o'clock race for the specialty classes had some what of a problem with all the riders getting on the proper starting line. (This seems to happen altogether to often with this race.) Although some of the confusion was caused by a new starting order because of the added Super Senior C class and the combination of some other classes on the starting line. 157 riders had entered the 13 classes. The largest class was Senior C with 33 entries. All classes had to go 3 laps with the exception of Master B, Women and Mini A & B's they had to race for two laps around the fast 13 mile track. Super Senior A rider Suzuki RMX rider, Marvin Williams from Titusville, put it on the rest of his class and anyone else by moving out to a two minute lead on the rest of the riders. Ken New, who has just moved up to Senior A, was second over all in the race and took first in his class. Bill Parker took a first in the Senior B class. In one of the tightest finishes of the day

Jim Petrosky came in first followed by, Cliff Golby 2nd, Gates Pelletier 3rd, then Ernie Cox 4th and Roland Lyons 5th. 107 ticks of the watch separated these 5 riders after 39 miles racin in the woods...that's good close fun racing. Senior C winner Gary Rorstrom had the fastest line in his race and blew away the competition by 6 minutes. Despite many problems (see letters to the editor) Ron Stone was able to finish a blink under 2 minutes ahead of the rest of the Super Senior C riders. In the Womens race Cheryl Myers won the "A" class and Delena Johnson on her new YZ 125 blew away the "B" ladies.

The Noon Race

This race is for the "AA", "A" and "B" riders and starting this year the four strokes have been included. It is quite evident with the start of each class in this race that these riders are quick and serious about their racing. First on the line is the "AA" class. Last years scrambles champ Kenny Kelyon, MX rider Kevin Foley, FTR-V President Robbie Possehl, South Florida MX ace Jim Royko, Russ Human from the Tampa area and last but not least the FTR's own "Bo" (Bo knows motorcycles) Tillman. I had to mention this because Bo has a knack of being first into the first corner of most every race he rides, problem is it goes down hill from there. Well you guys look out rumor has it Bo is buyin a brand new bike..., getin in shape..., and is gona quite drinkin what ever it is that makes his arms turn to cement during the first lap. Today was just like the story above with Bo first into the first corner followed by a bunch of the quickest riders in the state. All the classes in A-B race had to ride 3 laps and when they came around the first time Kenny Keylon had a huge lead on the rest of the pack. At the finish it was Keylon 1st, with Robbie Possehl 2nd, followed 15 seconds later by Kevin Fowley. The A-Open race was a story in itself. Super fast Mr. Goodguy, Kenny Boyd found out that Bobby Moarity (A-125 rider) wouldn't have his new RM-125 in time for the race so he made arrangements for Bobby to borrow a bike for this race. "Yeah Kenny" only problem was the bike was a Suzuki DR350 (4 stroke) so Bobby would have to race in the A-Open class against his buddy Kenny. Bobby thanked him a whole lot and then went out and beat Kenny by 19 seconds to win the class on the borrowed 4 stroke. Mike Phillips had a good race. He won the A-250 class and was 4th overall in the race. Alex Cox, last years B-125 winner, had an impressive win in the A-125 class. Allen Scott and Matt Osborn finishing 2nd and 3rd with only 14 second separating them. Jeff seperating took the win in the B-250 class by 7 seconds over Iain Johnston and in the B-125 class only 42 seconds separated 1st Jeff Hirsberg, 2nd Erin Mc Kenzie, and 3rd William Hooper.

In the closest finish of the day Jeff Affeld and Joseph Cassady finished 1 second apart to take 1st and 2nd in the C-125 class.

BEHIND THE SCENES by J. Thomas
It takes long and many hours to make a successful event come off. You have to know that many people worked hard to get the job done. Quite a few Apollo Club members spent a lot of time helping the folks from CMRA get not one but two courses laid out and arrowed for the Deer Park H/S. The folks from Apollo should be applauded for their help and interest in the sport of hare scrambles racing.

While the majority of the A, B and C riders were back in the pits getting ready and anticipating the days race a couple of riders were out on the track helping the 10 o'clock race riders stuck in a mud hole and then with a help of an axe and machete the two cleared out the bottle neck so riders could have a better shot at a ditch crossing that was causing a lot of problems. This ditch was right next to the main entrance road and while these two rider were out speculating they happen upon the problem. C-250 rider, Chris Gallagher jumped right in and with the help of Scott Gawler who was working the event as a course marshall must have physically removed 30 to 40 riders that were stuck and unable to move and would have been there for quite some time had these guys not gotten them out. In the mean time Kenny Keylon happened by and with the axe and a machete started hacking away at the bushes on both sides of the trail Criss Gallagher jumped in and also helped. In about 15 to 20 minutes they had straighten out the trail and used the cut down brush to fill the bike stopping ruts at the ditch. The riders seemed to be able to handle the ditch a lot better due to the new approach and the brush filled ruts were easier to ride through. After about 45 minutes Kenny and Chris left to go back to the starting area. Kenny had to race in the next race and went on to high point the event. That's a lot of activity in one day for a guy that had not ridden all summer. Chris took 2nd place in the super large C-250 class. Thanks to Chris, Kenny and Scott a whole

bunch of riders ended up with a decent day of racing instead of a disastrous one.

The structure of the FTR magazine has always been a "Good News Magazine". While we recognize and hope that the membership realizes that riding and especially racing dirt bikes has a high risk factor we have refrained from reporting to the membership each and every accident or injury that occurs at FTR Sanction events. Because it isn't written on the pages of this magazine doesn't mean the thoughts and prayers are not with any member that has been injured in any way. The following is a break from tradition, but we thought that you would like to read about it.

During the morning race Suzanne Dick a popular young rider from the Miami area was injured when a tree jumped out in front of her. She was air lifted to a local hospital and released that afternoon to go home. There she was admitted to a hospital near her home and spent a week there. Since that time she has been release and is at home now and doing as well as can be expected. Many "THANKS" to Senior C rider Greg Schaef who stopped competing during the race to assist Suzanne and then determined that she was hurt severe enough that he should carefully get her back to the start on his bike. Good work Greg!

Another rider who stopped to help a down rider was 4 Stroke A rider Art Whitney. During the noon race Art came up on B-250 rider Dave Wagner, a Orlando motorcycle shop owner who had hit the ground pretty hard. Art stayed there till Dave felt better (about 7 or 8 minutes) and then continued on.

Isn't it great to know that the FTR has members that will go out of their way to help other riders in their time of need or will help fix something that is obviously wrong with out being asked. These are just a few of probalble hundreds of stories concerning the Deer Park race. I thought you might be interested in hearing about them.

That translates to a 39 mile run. I ride a 125 cc Honda and can only go a little over 30 miles. No problem, I'm by myself (no pit crew) this should prove interesting. I took my gas can and spare goggles over to the gas area got instructions on where to pit and left my gear along the ribbon.

The race start was fine perhaps a little crowded but fun. I ran hard knowing that I was the only one going to have to pit. (Thanks to all the red and blue plates that let me by) I came into the pits with the lead, found about 10 gas cans under the ribbon, but not mine. Made a frantic search and I mean seriously (frantic) search. No gas can. What a nightmare, I busted my butt the first 2 laps because of this pit stop, no gas. No goggles. A kind gentleman came to my aid. He asked what kind of pre-mix I was running. I told him it did not matter at that point.
