



Quick Guide for Eyelash and Eyebrow Tint by Hairpearl

Preliminary: The client should remove contact lenses or glasses and the clients' hair should be pulled back from the face with a [headband](#) or cap. Ideally, the client should be seated comfortably upright with head titled slightly back or in a chair reclined slightly backward.

Step 1: Mix the Hairpearl Tint with Hairpearl Cream Developer Oxidant using a 1:1 ratio. You may wish to use a small glass [mixing dish](#). Don't use metal, as the color may react. For Eyelash tinting, using the 3% Developer is recommended. The consistency should be a creamy paste (not too runny). Allow the mixed tint to sit for about 3 minutes while you prepare your client.

Note: Shake the Developer well before mixing with tint. The color of the mixture is not the color the hair will be once tinted. To get an idea of the final color, leave a wooden applicator in the mixture for the desired time.

Step 2: Cleanse eyebrows and eyelashes with Hairpearl [Lash & Brow Shampoo Foam](#) to remove any makeup, dirt, or oil. Lashes and brows should be clean and dry before applying the tint product. Take a "Before" photo if desired.

Step 3: If tinting eyelashes, instruct the client to look up. Remove the protective backing from the self adhesive [Aloe Eye Gel Patches](#) and place them under the eye, as close to the lower lash line as possible, without covering lower lashes. Ensure the lashes are completely dry before applying any tint.

You may also use the waxed Hairpearl [Protection Papers](#). To do so, first apply a layer of Hairpearl Relaxing Eye Cream under the lower eyelid. Then place a waxed Hairpearl Protection Paper on top of the cream under the lower lid, which will prevent the tint from staining the skin. The cream helps to hold the waxed paper in place.

Step 4: With your client looking up, use a Hairpearl [Tint Brush](#) with a round tip to carefully apply the tint mixture to the lower lashes on both eyes first. Ensure the tint covers all lashes, including baby lashes and those at the corners of the eyes. **When lower lashes are completed, instruct the client to close their eyes and keep them closed until the entire tint application and removal process is complete.** Apply the tint mixture to upper lashes from base to tip. Ensure all of the lashes are thoroughly coated. Avoid contact with the eyelid. Allow eyelashes to develop for 8-10 minutes.

If tint accidentally gets in eyes, flush the eyes with plain water immediately!

Step 5: Mix the preferred color for the eyebrows with the same procedure as above. Using a disposable brush or Tint Brush with a [Slant Tip](#), apply tint to the eyebrows in the direction of hair growth. Ensure the brow hair is completely covered. Remove any excess color from the skin around the brows with a cotton swab to tint and enhance the desired shape.

Allow eyebrows to develop 3-4 minutes, depending on the desired intensity of the color. The longer the development time, the more intense the color will be. If necessary, begin with 2 minutes and then check the color. You may reapply for a minute or longer if a darker color is desired. Color results may vary based on the color of the clients hair. Gray or coarse hair may need additional developing time.

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Note: When combining the tint with a Lash Lift or Brow Lamination service, **REDUCE** the development time for the tint! Allow to develop 3 minutes for lashes and 1-2 minutes for brows.

Step 6: After sufficient development time for the eyelashes, carefully remove the protecting papers from under the eyes. The client should keep their eyes closed. Use a lightly dampened cotton pad wetted with warm water to remove the tint until no residue is visible. Use a downward motion to clean the lashes of all product. Hold a tissue near the eye area to capture any excess water.

After sufficient development time on the brows, gently remove the color from the eyebrows with a lightly dampened cotton pad wetted with warm water. Use an upward and outward motion to remove product from the brows until no residue is visible.

Step 7: Using a disposable [mascara wand](#), apply the [Moist After Care Serum](#) to moisturize and nourish the lashes and brows. Take an "After" photo if desired.

This product may cause allergic reactions in certain individuals. A preliminary spot test may be made. To perform the test, a small area of skin behind the ear or on the inner surface of the forearm should be cleansed and apply a small quantity of tint as prepared for treatment use and allowed to dry. After 24 hours, the area should be washed gently with soap and water. If no irritation or inflammation is apparent, it may be assumed that no hypersensitivity to the dye exists.

In case of any cutaneous reactions; like redness, itching, or rash, rinse the affected area immediately with clear water and do not continue procedure. Get medical consultations before starting procedures. If the product is exposed to the eye, rinse the eyes thoroughly with cool, clear water.

After Care Recommendations:

- Do not touch or rub your eyes, eyelashes, or eyebrows immediately after the treatment.
- If redness or any irritation occurs, apply a cool damp cotton compress to the eye area. If symptoms persist, seek medical advice.
- The effect of the tint will start to diminish within 3-4 weeks as hair grows out and the tint color fades. Strong sunlight/UV light can make the tint color fade faster.
- Avoid washing your eyebrows and eyelashes (and swimming) for 24 hours, as these activities can cause the tint results to fade. Avoid exfoliating facial cleansers. Products containing AHA's or other chemical exfoliants may decrease the life of the tint.
- Do not apply makeup or mascara or receive any other eye treatments for at least 24 hours after the tint service.
- Try to use oil free facial products around the eye area to prolong the tint color.
