
- **Take care in uncrating and moving.
- **Use safe lifting practices or a mechanical material lift to help set the top slab.
- 1) Be sure the surface you plan to install on is flat and level.
- 2) Set legs in desired position. They must be plumb and parallel with each other. Measure the stone top to be sure the legs are located correctly.
- 3) We recommend using a construction adhesive, such as Loctite PL, or an epoxy, such as Loctite 5 minute epoxy, between the legs and top for the sturdiest installation. The adhesive must be formulated for use with marble to prevent possible staining.

Care & Maintenance: Your bench has been factory sealed using a high quality impregnating sealer. Time and environmental factors slowly degrade this seal and re-application will be necessary. Clean with a soft rag and a stone cleaner.

Test the sealer several times per year by splashing a few drops of water on the surface. If beading occurs, the seal is still good. If the water spreads or soaks into the stone, it is time to re-apply.

Use only stone cleaners and stone sealers that are specifically for use on marble and follow the manufacturers instructions.
