


**Lower Engine Mount**For: 2013 Ford Focus ST


Installation Instructions For Kit #555-4017

- A qualified technician should be used if you are not confident with replacing the factory lower engine mount.
- A Ford service manual should be used in tandem with these instructions for further assistance, and torque specifications.

## **Removal of the factory Engine Mount**


- 1. Lift the front of the car so that the front wheels are off the ground, and you have enough room to work under the engine. Use caution operating a lift or jack stands to ensure the car is stable, and safe, to work around, and underneath.
- 2. Remove the lower splash shield.
- **3.** Remove the six nuts securing the two exhaust brackets to the mount. See figure 1. Remove the brackets and set aside.
- **4.** Remove the three bolts securing the "front" mount to the transmission. See figure 2.
- **5.** Remove the large bolt in the subframe securing the "rear" mount to the chassis. See figure 3.
- 6. Place a small prybar between the subframe/chassis and the transmission and gently pry the drivetrain forward while maneuvering the mount assembly out. Make sure not to pry against any lines or harnesses.











## **Assembly of the Steeda Engine Mount**

- 7. The mount comes with the 70 durometer (softer) bushings already installed in the mount. If you chose to use the 88 durometer (firmer), or a combination of the two bushings you will need to swap them. To do so:
  - a. Remove the top and bottom steel washers and set aside.
  - b. Push the steel center sleeve out.
  - c. Pry the bushings out with a screwdriver.
  - d. Install the new bushings in the same orientation.
  - e. Generously apply the provided grease to the faces of the bushings that the steel washers and sleeve mate with.
  - f. Reinstall the steel sleeve
  - g. Reinstall the steel washers.



## **Installation of the Steeda Engine Mount**

- **8.** Install the Steeda engine mount in the same location and orientation as the factory mount, in the subframe. Do not reinstall the large through bolt, yet
- **9.** Reinstall the "front" mount bracket into position. You may need to gently maneuver/pry the drivetrain a bit to fit the mount(s) back into place.
- 10. Reinstall, and reuse, all the factory bolts.
  - a. Secure the clevis end of the Steeda mount to the "front" mount with the factory through bolt and the provided lock nut. Torque to 83 ft-lbs.
- 11. Reinstall the exhaust brackets.
- 12. Reinstall the splash shield. You are done!
