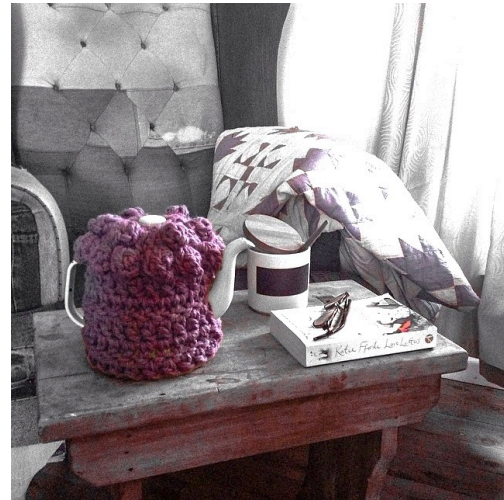
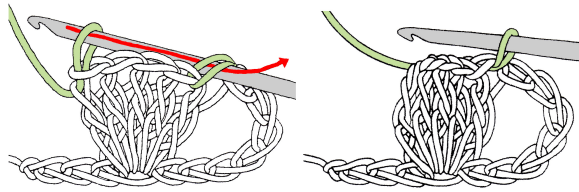


Pop into Nundle Tea Cozy...

20 ply Nundle wool.
10mm crochet hook
Wool needle
Falcon enamel teapot 1.5 litre.
Abbreviations:
ch - chain
dc - double crochet
tr - treble
sl st - slip stitch.



POPCORN STITCH...



To make the popcorn stitch...

Work 4 tr in the same stitch, drop loop from hook, insert hook from front to back in the top of the first tr at start group ... then pull dropped loop through stitch.

To Start

Make a circle by chaining 10 and joining with a sl st.
You will want your circle to fit nicely around the top of the mound in the teapot lid you may need more or less chains depending on your tension...

Row 1.

1 ch, 12 dc into circle join with a sl st to first dc.

Row 2.

Popcorn Stitch in the same spot as the sl st from previous row, this one is slightly different as it is the start of the row so you need to do 3ch which will be your first tr and add 3 tr into the same place to complete the Popcorn...

(3 tr into next dc, Popcorn stitch into next dc). Repeat (-) till the end finishing with 3 tr in last stitch. Sl st to 3rd ch at beginning of round.

You will have 6 Popcorns in total.

Row 3.

3 ch, Popcorn stitch into next stitch, (1 tr into next stitch. Popcorn into next stitch) Repeat (-) till end. Sl st to 3rd ch at beginning of round.

You will have 12 Popcorns in total.

The next section will be worked in two identical halves and sew together later.

Row 4 – Row 8.

3 ch, 1 tr each into next 11 stitches. Turn work over.

At the end of row 8 Fasten off, leaving a thread to sew together once finished.

Other side matching previous side.

Attach yarn to Row 3 in the next stitch after the completed side.

Work rows as for Row 4 – Row 8. As below...

3 ch, 1 tr each into next 11 stitches. Turn work over.

At the end of row 8 finish but use the remaining thread to sew up the sides to match the shape of your teapot, do the same for other side. Fasten off.
