Wooden Section Instruction Guide

These steps guide you through getting your wooden sections ready to put in the hive.

Soaking the crease

- 1. Bundle 12 or so flat packed sections together
- 2. Line up all the creases then sit them over a sink.
- 3. Get a small jug of boiling water and slowly pour water down the creases to soften the timber.
- 4. Repeat for all the crease lines on the timber so that the timber is fully soaked on the crease line and will fold easily. See the picture below.



Folding and Fitting foundation

- 1. Gently fold the wooden sections into a square shape. If it sounds like one of them is going to snap, soften the crease a bit more.
- 2. One of the two ends will have been cut in half to the crease. Fold just one half and connect it to the other end of the wooden section like below.



- 3. Sit the foundation in the square with one end sitting on the lip of the half side.
- 4. Fold the foundation over the lip to hold it in place See Picture on the reverse
- 5. Fold the other half side so it locks into place and secures the foundation See Picture on the reverse
- 6. Place the wooden section in a frame so the foundation is held at the top and the sheet hangs.
