# USER GUIDE

## APPLE GARDE RAIN & STAIN REPELLENT

### WHAT YOU NEED

#### BEFORE YOU START MAKE SURE YOU ARE PREPARED

---

- Clean your item to be treated before using the Repellent. Make sure the item is dry, clean and free of dust, dirt or grease.
- Always do a patch test in a hidden area of your item to check colour-fastness.
- Prepare a space for cleaning by laying out cloth or towel on the floor or table in an outdoor or well-ventilated environment. Do not expose to direct sunlight.

## METHOD

**1**

Hold the repellent about 6 to 9 inches away from the surface of your item. Spray it lightly and evenly in a sweeping motion. Include all seams and trims when spraying but do not soak it.

---

**2**

Allow your item to dry for about 20 to 30 minutes before wiping the remaining spray off the surface. Do not apply heat or speed drying.

---

**3**

Leave your item to further dry for at least an hour, or leave it overnight if possible before using it to avoid contact with sensitive skin.

If you have more time at hand, consider:

Spraying one side of the item thoroughly, leave it to dry with the spray side not touching the floor or table for 24 hours. Repeat the same process for the other side of the item.

## PRECAUTIONARY NOTE

---

- Keep the Repellent out of reach of children and away from extreme temperature. When exposed to direct sunlight or stored above 120 degree fahrenheit (49 degree-celsius), the can may burst.
- Do not transport, use, store or dispose the Repellent or its content near sources of ignition or heat.
- Do not allow the solution to get into the eyes or consumed internally.
- Do not smoke while using it and take care not to puncture or incinerate (burn) the Repellent can.
- Do not use your treated item until it is totally dry to avoid any possibility of skin irritation or stain on your skin or clothing.
- Avoid breathing in the spray mist and vapour, or exposing children and pets to it.
- Always wash your hands with soap and water after use and before touching eyes or consuming food with your hands.

## REMEMBER

**1** Always conduct a patch test on an inconspicuous area of your item to ensure that the product is suitable for use before proceeding further.

---

**2** The surface of the treated item may look darker when you first treated it. It should lighten up when it is completely dry.

---

**3** Read the manufacturer's tags or instructions before applying any treatment or solution to your item to ensure maximum protection and adherence.
