The 6mm Polyester cables can hold up to 400 pounds of pressure.



Crinkle 210T Ripstop Nylon has triple-stitched seams for strength.



Carabiners engineered to hold 660 lbs of static load.

### **Instructions**

When hanging your TRIBE PROVISIONS Hammock, we suggest you attach the two ends of the hammock to two separate trees. In our experience, attaching the ends of the hammock to the same tree does not provide optimal comfort.

When selecting the trees, please observe a few general guidelines:

- The trees must be roughly ten feet apart.
- They must stand tall enough to be able to anchor your hammock ties six feet off the ground.
- They must be mature enough to withstand the tensile forces produced by your weight.
- The trees must be sufficiently anchored to the ground.


Do not use saplings, unanchored lumber, or humans as they do not provide enough stability to ensure safety & comfort.

Once your trees have been selected, use the supplied nylon rope to attach the hammock to the tree. **(FIG 1)** While you are at liberty to consult your sailor on the appropriate knot, we recognize that you are likely to use your new Adventure Hammock at times and in places without access to nautical resources.

Follow these instructions (FIG 2): fold your nylon rope in half, tie a simple overhand knot to both ends of the rope. Tie additional overhand knots throughout the length of the rope. Wrap this tied rope around one of the trees and thread the end through the loop at the fold in the rope. Latch the carabiner between the tied rope so that it rests against one of the knots.

Do the same on the second tree. Adjust the carabiner to the knots until you obtain the desired hanging angle for your hammock.
