- Even if the helmet is not showing damage after impact, it might still be structurally compromised. Have the helmet inspected by a professional before using again.
- If you are not sure if the helmet is in proper condition, you should replace it.
- Helmets only protect the areas they cover; they do not protect the neck and face.
- Make sure the helmet is properly fitted and positioned correctly before each use.
- No helmet can protect against all possible impacts. Serious injury or death can occur.

### IF YOU HAVE AN ACCIDENT

A fall or relatively hard impact can damage the helmet, even if no damage can be seen from the outside. It is necessary to replace your helmet after any such incident as the impact could have caused unseen structural damage. A helmet that has sustained an impact should be returned to the manufacturer for inspection, or be destroyed and replaced.

### CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Any alteration to the helmet is prohibited. Regularly inspect your helmet and replace it when it shows signs of obvious wear.
- Clean your helmet with mild soap and water only. Never use petroleum products, ammonia or bleach cleaning agents as this may damage the helmet. This damage may not be visible to user
- Wash the removable lining with mild soap and water as well. Then air dry it.
- Do not expose to direct sunlight or extreme heat, such as in the interior of your car on a sunny day. Store your helmet in a cool, dry place.

### SAFETY + CERTIFICATION

**WARNING** This helmet is intended solely for normal bicycle use only. It is not suitable for use in other sports, such as motorcycling, bmx, downhill or extreme offroad use. This helmet should not be used by children while climbing or any activity where there is a risk of strangulation/hanging if the child.

No helmet can protect against all possible impacts. Serious injury or death can occur even while wearing this helmet. This helmet cannot protect the user from injuries to the neck, spine or other body parts. To maximize protection, this helmet must fit in accordance with the manufacturer's fitting instructions. Replace this helmet immediately if it has been subject to any impact even if no damage is visible. Any impact may damage the internal of this helmet and reduce its ability to protect the user from further impacts. Any helmet with suspected damage should be destroyed or returned to the manufacturer. Clean this helmet only with water and mild soap, this helmet can be damaged by chemical cleaners, solvents or some hair care products. Keep your helmet away from heat sources and out of direct sunlight. Do not leave helmet in a direct heat or extreme heat. Even well cared helmets will deteriorate over time; an old helmet may not provide adequate protection even if it appears in good condition. Replace your helmet every 3 years. This helmet complies with U.S. CPSC Safety Standard for Bicycle Helmets for Persons Age 5 and Older.

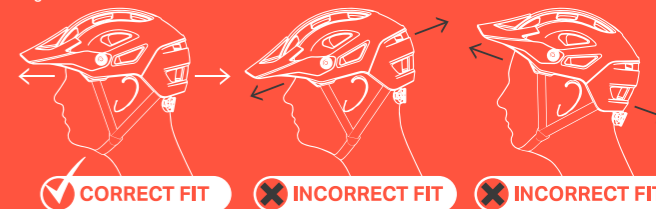

### SIZE AND FIT

#### THE CORRECT SIZE WILDHORN HELMET SHOULD FIT SNUG AND COMFORTABLE WITHOUT EXCESS MOVEMENT OR OBSTRUCTION.

- 1. Determine the right helmet liner insert size.** To find the right liner insert size for you, measure the circumference of your head one finger's breadth above your eyebrows. Liner sizes are indicated in the secondary packaging including alternate liner insert.
- 2. Confirm the correct liner.** To check that the helmet fits securely, leave the chin strap undone and shake your head lightly. The helmet should not change position.
- 3. Position correctly.** Make sure that the helmet is positioned horizontally on your head (see Figure 1). The helmet should neither sit too far back on the head, as this leaves the forehead unprotected, nor be pulled down too far over the forehead, as this could obstruct your view.
- 4. Adjust the chinstrap.** Fasten the buckle and adjust the chinstrap by pulling on the loose end of the strap. It should be snug under your chin, but not constrictive when you open your mouth. You may further adjust the side strap dividers to tighten the fit.
- 5. Fit system adjustment.** With the size adjustment system you can calibrate the size of your helmet to fit you perfectly: just put it on in the correct position and turn the adjustment knob - clockwise to tighten the fit, counterclockwise to loosen it.
