- If you are not sure if the helmet is in proper condition, you should replace it.
- Helmets only protect the areas they cover; they do not protect the neck and face.
- Make sure the helmet is properly fitted and positioned correctly before each use.

IF YOU HAVE AN ACCIDENT

A fall or relatively hard impact can damage the helmet, even if no damage can be seen from the outside. It is necessary to replace your helmet after any such incident as the impact could have caused unseen structural damage.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- . Any alteration to the helmet is prohibited. Regularly inspect your helmet and replace it when it shows signs of obvious wear.
- . Clean your helmet with mild soap and water only. Never use petroleum products, cleaning agents, paints and decals other than those provided.
- Wash the removable lining with mild soap and water as well. Then air dry it.
- Do not expose to direct sunlight or extreme heat, such as in the interior of your car on a sunny day. Store your helmet in a cool, dry place.

CERTIFICATION

Wildhorn helmets comply with the European standard EN1077 Class B and / or the US standard F2040 (refer to label inside the helmet), They comply with the EEC Directive 89/686,

They are intended solely for use in downhill skiing and snowboarding. It is not suitable for use in other sports, such as motorcycling, unless specifically indicated by the label inside the helmet.

Winter sports such as skiing and snowboarding are inherently dangerous. No helmet can guarantee the user will not sustain serious or fatal injuries resulting from impacts.

The helmets classes A and B are for alpine skiers, skiers and snowboarders, Class A helmets offer protection on the top of the helmet. Class B helmets provide better ventilation and allow for better hearing, but don't provide as much protection against penetration.

SIZE AND FIT

THE CORRECT SIZE WILDHORN HELMET SHOULD FIT SNUG AND COMFORTABLE WITHOUT EXCESS MOVEMENT OR OBSTRUCTION.

- 1. Determine the right helmet size. To find the right helmet size for you, measure the circumference of your head one finger's breadth above your evebrows.
- 3. Adjust liners. Your Spire helmet comes with 2 interchangeable liners, A pre-installed 5mm thick liner as well as a secondary 3mm thick liner to choose from based on your optimal fit and
- 2. Confirm the correct size. To check that the helmet fits securely, leave the chin strap undone and shake your head lightly. The helmet should not change position.
- 3. Position correctly, Make sure that the helmet is positioned horizontally on your head (see Figure 1). The helmet should not sit too far back on the head, as this leave the forehead unprotected, nor be pulled down too far over the forehead, as this could obstruct your view,
- 4. Adjust the chinstrap. Fasten the buckle and adjust the chinstrap by pulling on the loose end of the strap, it should be snug under your chin, but not constrictive when you open your mouth, You may further adjust the side strap dividers to tighten the fit.
- 5. Fit system adjustment. With the size adjustment system you can calibrate the size of your helmet to fit you perfectly: just put it on in the correct position and turn the adjustment knob clockwise to tighten the fit, counterclockwise to loosen it.
- 6. Removable Sound Curtain. If desired, the Sound Curtain can be removed by pulling directly on the ear cover while securely holding the helmet. Undo the two arms and remove the cover then replace the arms and lining,
