

2013 Valdiguié Solano County Green Valley (550 cases):

Here's something you don't see everyday but maybe you would 50-100 years ago. What use to be called Napa Gamay is actually a grape called Valdiguié, originally grown in southwest part of France. These grapes come from two ranches, Wirth and Frei, both planted in 1948 and 1950 respectively. One being planted on steep sloped, iron rich soil. The other being located closer to the valley floor with more acidic soils. Light, fresh and lively.
