

BROC CELLARS | 2016 LAGREIN ROSE

VARIETAL: 100% Lagrein

VINEYARD: Lone Pine Vineyard

LOCATION: El Dorado County, CA

ALCOHOL: 13%

TOTAL PRODUCTION: 192 cases

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Foot stomped in ½ Ton bins and left on the skins for 1 hour. Slow pressed for 3 hours and transferred into stainless steel. Transferred once more into neutral French oak barrels for 36 hours, then racked off the lees and transferred for the final time into our concrete egg. The numerous bottles of Nusserhoff's Lagrein Rose that I have enjoyed over the years from Alto Adige inspire this wine. We are very excited to work with Lagrein and are already thinking about what we will do with the next vintage!

VITICULTURAL AREA:

Lone Pine Vineyard is farmed by Charlie Cosens, where he grows Lagrein, Refosco and Chardonnay. The vineyard is located in El Dorado County, just outside of Placerville. It is at 1700 ft elevation and consists of volcanic rock, shale and fine grained granite.

All our wines are made naturally, meaning no use of inoculated yeasts or bacteria. We use only native yeast to spark fermentation. We do not add any powdered tannins or enzymes. A minimal dose of S02 is added 4 weeks before bottling to some wines.

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
