VARIETALS: 90% Valdiguié, 8% Zinfandel, 2% Trousseau

VINEYARDS: Solano Vineyard (Valdiguié), Arrowhead Mountain (Zinfandel), Wirth Vineyard (Trousseau).

LOCATION: Suisun Valley

ALCOHOL: 11%

TOTAL PRODUCTION: 2250 cases

WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

The fruit was destemmed, then pressed into stainless steel. All 3 varietals fermented together just over 30 days. The wine was bottled at the beginning of the year. High aromatics with juicy watermelon and grapefruit notes. Spice comes from the Zinfandel, acidity from the Valdiguié and texture from the Trousseau.

VITICULTURAL AREA:

Suisun Valley is located just east of Napa Valley. Both the Solano and Wirth Vineyard vines grow on sandy loam. Arrowhead Mountain Vineyard grows on volcanic rock.

Our wines are made naturally with no use of inoculated yeasts or bacteria. We use only native yeast to spark fermentation. We do not add any powdered tannins or enzymes. A minimal dose of SO2 is added 4 weeks before bottling to some wines.
