



2020 Notes & Tones

A special limited edition wine released with the album Notes & Tones in 2023. Made in collaboration with DJ Muggs, Now-Again and Broc Cellars.

THE STORY: Natural wine can feel obscure. Natural in what way? What we mean: Notes & Tones is a wine made organically without chemical pesticides or fertilizers, unnecessary intervention, and no fining, filtering or sulfites added. This wine is a *living*, evolving thing and an homage to the skin-contact wines of old for the modern age. Inspired by the natural wine titans of Italy and France. This limited release wine is named for jazz drummer Art Taylor's influential book.

Notes & Tones is a blend of two Italian varieties from Fox Hill Vineyard. The Tocai Friulano was fermented on the skins with native yeasts in sandstone jarres for 10 days, then basket pressed back into the jarres to age. The Trebbiano was fermented with native yeasts on its skins for three days, then pressed into sandstone jarres to finish fermentation and aged for 10 months. No sulfur added during fermentation, aging or at bottling.

Fox Hill is an organically farmed, 60-acre vineyard on Mendocino benchland between Hopland and Ukiah. A little slice of Italy home to 25 Italian grape varieties. Chris Brockway of Broc Cellars farms Fox Hill Vineyards, a unique vineyard in Northern California.
