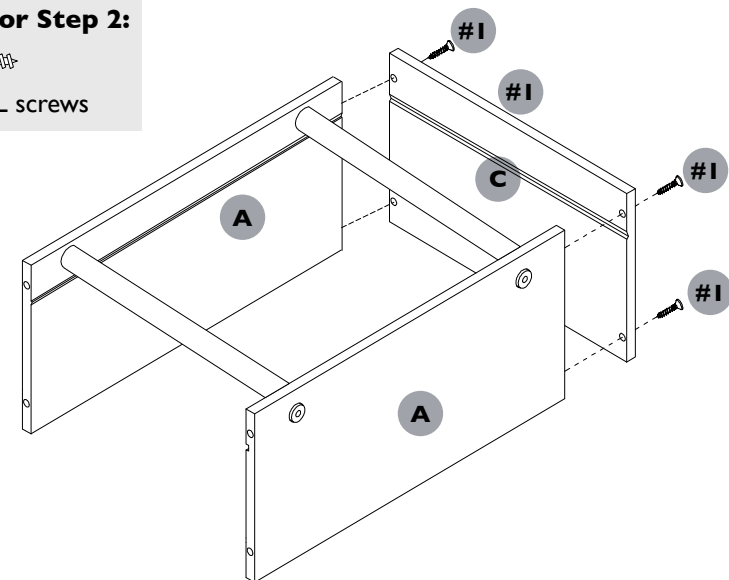


### STEP 1:

Insert both axles (B) into the holes on both side panels (A).

4x #1 25mmL screws



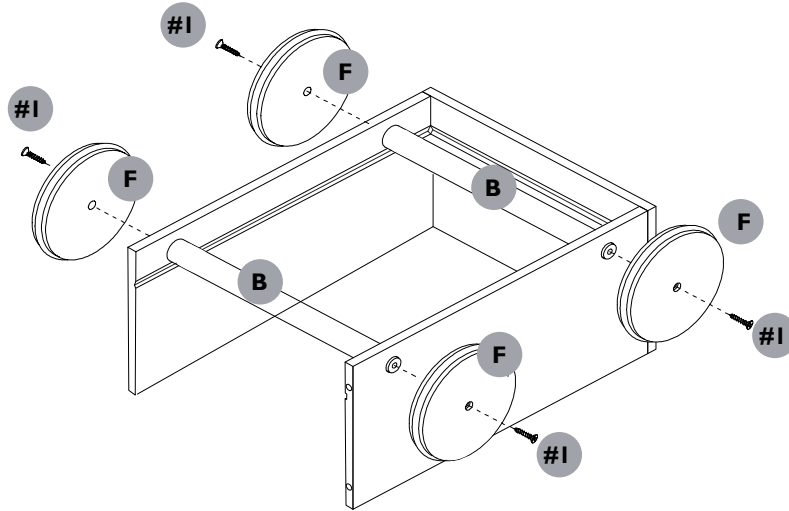
### STEP 2:

Attach back panel (C) to side panels (A) using 4x screws (#1).

4x #1 25mmL screws

Attach the 4x wheels (F) to the axles (B) using 4x screws (#1).

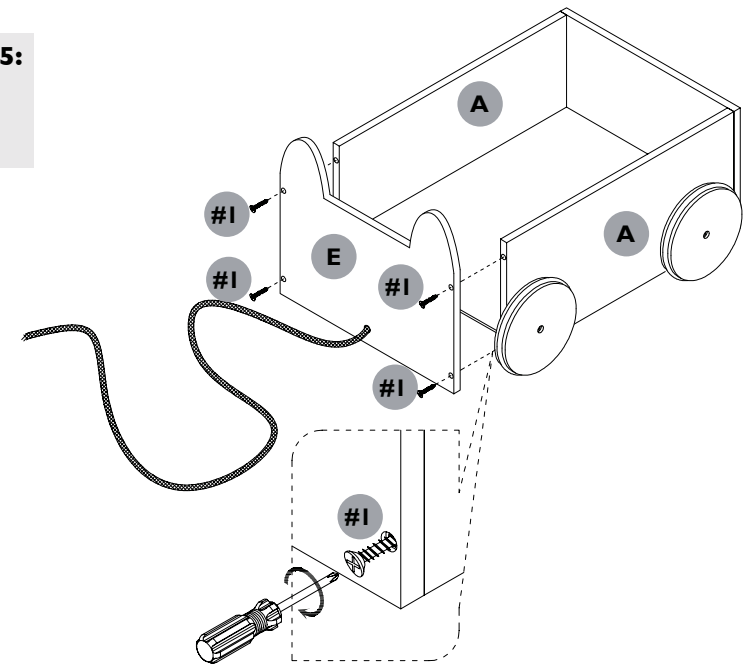


**Hardware for Step 5:**

  
4x #1 25mmL screws

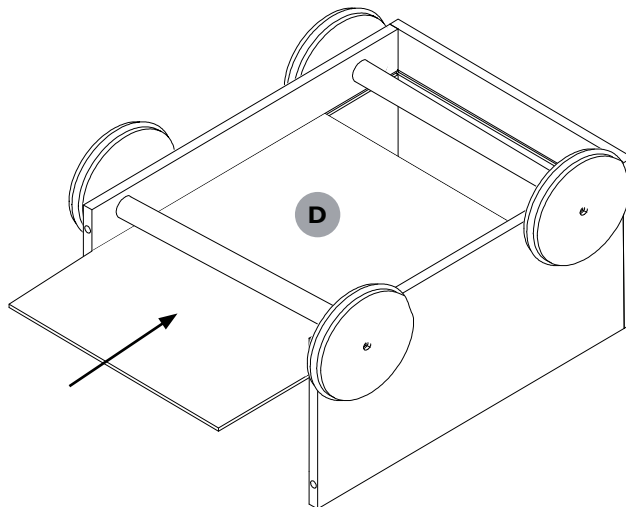
**STEP 5:**

Attach front panel (E) to side panels (A) using 4x screws (#1).



**STEP 4:**

Carefully slide the base panel (D) into the grooves as shown.



The assembly is now complete.
