NB: Applications must be received by the Monday prior to the market you wish to attend by no later than 12pm.

- The market runs every Saturday, June 15th to September 14th, 9am to 1pm.
- There is no minimum number of weeks required to attend the market. More dates can be added once you sign up granted there is space available.
- The market runs rain or shine. Cancellation will only be determined the morning of the market
- You are responsible to bring your own tent, table and chairs unless you are renting a covered space. In that case, a cover is provided.
- We only allow items that are made, baked or grown by the seller.
- All food vendors are required to fill out a MB Health form which is to be submitted with their application
