ABOUT THE VINEYARD

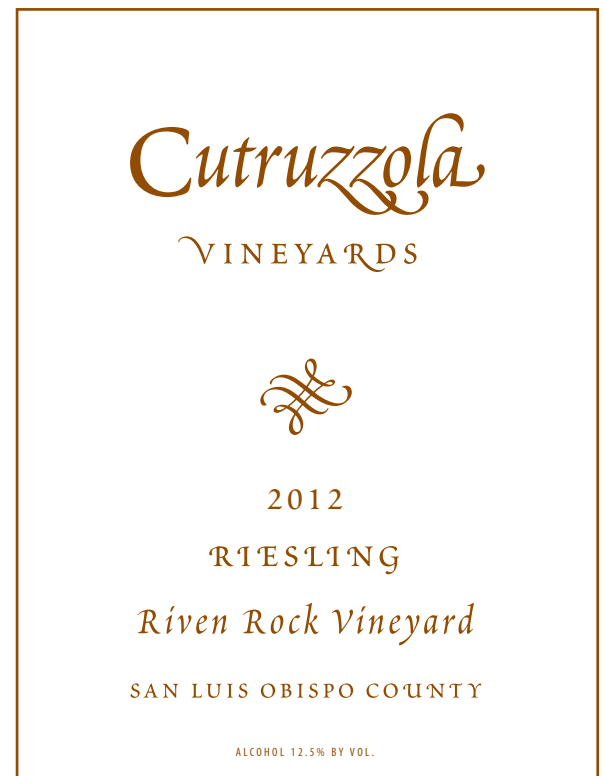
Cutruzzola Vineyards is located in a coastal valley stretching east from the town of Cambria on steep, predominately south-facing broken hills. The vineyard consists of five acres of Pinot Noir (clones 5, 667, 828, 115 and 23) and two acres of Riesling (clones 2 and 10), mostly on lime bearing soils. The remaining portion of the 47-acre property has been left in its natural state. The deepening roots of the vines, now between 9 and 14 years old, enabled the vines to flourish through another year of drought with minimal irrigation.

The Riesling was harvested on October 10th and October 12th. A long, cool fermentation on D-47 yeast was stopped at 2.3% residual sugar in order to balance the 3.05pH. The wine was bottled on May 20, 2013. A total of 440 cases were produced.

Tasting Note: Intense notes of lime, orange blossom and crushed stone on the nose. A hint of petroleum is also now developing. These flavors carry through on the palate, revealing a creaminess and vibrant acidity with an elegant finish. While this wine can be enjoyed now, we anticipate it to age exceptionally well.
