



Introduction

Watershot® Incorporated continues the company's water imaging legacy with the 5th purpose-built Camera Housing for the Apple iPhone®, Watershot® PRO for iPhone 7°. For those who have traded their digital cameras, for the simplicity of using their smart phone, the Watershot® PRO for iPhone 7® is a multi-feature waterproof Housing specifically made to optimize the iPhone 7's extraordinary photo and video imaging capabilities. New with the Watershot PRO iP7 Housing, is the option of selecting between and using either the Apple Camera App, standard on your iPhone 7°, or using the free Watershot° App available for download at the App Store.

The Watershot® PRO for iPhone 7® is complete with a multi-element Glass Lens Port, light baffle, wrist lanyard, and a smart yet robust & simple mounting system. Able to withstand 60 meters of depth (195 feet), the iPhone 7° is fully suspended within the Housing, ensuring that it is effectively shielded from abrasion, shock and pressure.

(4) **Initial Waterproof Confidence Test Instructions**

Perform this confidence test prior to the 1st operational use of the Housing

- Inspect the Watershot PRO for iPhone Housing and ensure it is contaminant free and appears in new condition.
- 2. Confirm the Lens Port is snug to the Housing by grabbing the Diamond Knurl on the Lens Port and rotating Counterclockwise (CCW) and loosen ¼ turn (90 degrees of rotation) ther Clockwise (CW) to tighten so it is snug. DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN.
- Test Touch Screen Buttons. All buttons should return to original position after being depressed.
- Open the Housing by sliding the Cam Latch Lock Button with your thumb and simultaneously rotating the Cam Latch 180 degrees, Counter Clockwise CCW to the OPEN position.
- 5. Place a tissue or piece of paper inside the Housing.
- Close the Housing, ensuring that the Cam Latch is 'locked' to the CLOSED Position and that the Cam Latch Lock Button 'clicks' and 'pops' into the fully extended position.
- 7. Submerge the Housing in water for 5-10 minutes
- 8. Remove the Housing, dry it, and then open it.
- Check to ensure the tissue or paper is dry.

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10. Do not use if water is found inside the Housing. Contact Watershot support.

It is the user's responsibility properly test, use, care for, and store the product.

Watershot APP Installation Instructions

- 1. Download the "Watershot for iPhone" App from the App Store or iTunes.
- 2. Install the App onto your iPhone

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3. Drag the Watershot for iPhone App onto the "Menu Bar" located at the bottom of your "Home Screen". Make sure that you place the Watershot App in either the bottom right hand corner or bottom left hand corner, and then place the Apple Camera App in the opposite corner of the "Menu Bar". This action will allow you to select between and use either the Apple Camera App or the Watershot App.

iPhone 7[®] Settings Setup


- 1. Please open your phone and go into your iPhone Settings > Display & Brightness > Please check "DISPLAY ZOOM" and make sure your phone is set to Standard, not Zoomed.
- 2. Go into your iPhone Settings and click on Privacy, now click on Camera. Make sure the Watershot App has access to the Camera
- 3. Go into your iPhone Settings and click on Privacy, now click on Microphone. Make sure the Watershot App has access to the Microphone
- 4. Go into your iPhone Settings and click on Privacy, now click on Photos. Make sure the Watershot App has access to the Photo Album
- 5 Go into your iPhone Settings and scroll down to the Watershot app and click on it. Check to make sure the Watershot App has access to Photos, Microphone, and Camera

Using the Watershot PRO for iPhone

- 1. With the iPhone 7° , you now have the option to turn off the "Auto-lock" feature or turn off the "Passcode" feature. If you turn off the "Auto-Lock" feature your iPhone 7° will remain "Awake" the entire time that it is housed in the Watershot Housing. If you chose to turn off the "Passcode" feature you are disabling the "Touch ID, Password, and Swipe" features on the iPhone 7°. To "Wake" the iPhone 7° from the "Lock Screen", simply push the Home Button twice. This is a personal choice you should make about how you would like to setup your iPhone 7° for use in the Watershot PRO, so choose one or the other. Turning off both the "Auto-Lock" and the "Passcode" while entirely possible is not recommended
- 2. To turn off the "Auto-Lock" feature go into the General Settings of your iPhone 7° and click on "Display & Brightness", now click on "Auto-Lock" and place it to "Never." Once you place the iPhone inside of the Watershot Housing, it will not go to "Sleep", the iPhone 7° will remain "Awake" and the battery discharges continuously, providing the shortest batterylife from your iPhone 7°

So remember, if you did not turn the "Auto-Lock" feature on the iPhone 7° off, and it went to the Lock Screen, while it is inside of the Watershot Housing, there is no way of entering in your "Touch ID, Passcode, or Swipe" to unlock the iPhone


4. Turn your iPhone 7° on first then install your iPhone 7° into the Housing per the installation Instructions.

- 5. Press the "Home Button"
- 6. If you have installed the Watershot App and the Apple Camera App in the "Menu Bar" of your "Home Screen", all you need to do is the push the corresponding Touch Screen Button #1 or #3 on the Watershot Housing to open either the Watershot App or Apple Camera App. Once the App is open, to return to the "Home Screen" simply push the

Using the Watershot App

- *** Before you put your iPhone in the Watershot Housing, open the Watershot App and click the Watershot logo in the upper left hand corner, this will take you to the Open Mode Menu. Click on Housing Type and please select "PRO Housing (6 Buttons)". You will only need to do this once, as the App will save your selection. ***
- When you open the Watershot App it will automatically open in Picture mode, Press Button 1 to toggle between PHOTO and VIDEO mode



Using the Watershot App (Cont.)

- 2. Press Button 2 to take a picture when in PHOTO mode or to Start/Stop Recording when you are in VIDEO mode
- 3. Press Button 3 to switch to PLAYBACK mode. You can review Photos and Videos that you have taken with the Watershot App.
- 4. Press Button 4 to open the menu that allows you to change the settings and the operating
- 5. Press Button 5 to turn ON/OFF the focus lock feature (Only functions in PHOTO mode).
- 6. Press & Hold Button 2 to place the App in SLEEP MODE.

While in PLAYBACK Mode:

- 1. Press Button 1 to scroll FORWARD thru the recorded photos/videos
- 2. Press Button 2 to scroll BACKWARD thru the recorded photos/videos
- 3. Press & Hold Button 1 to PLAY the video displayed on the screen
- 4. Press Button 3 to switch back to CAMERA mode

Note: Additional App features may be accessed when the iPhone is not in the Housing. Press $\,$ the Watershot Wave Logo in the corner to access features such as: Tutorials, Action Camera Settings, Album, Housing Type, Activity Mode, Services, Licenses, and Info.

Installing the iPhone

 $Prior\ to\ installing\ the\ iPhone, ensure\ that\ Safety\ and\ Initial\ Waterproof\ Testing\ Instructions$ have been read, understood and followed



1. Open the Housing by sliding the Cam Latch Lock Button with your thumb and simultaneously rotating the Cam Latch 180 degrees, Counter Clockwise CCW to the OPEN position.

lengthwise (in the middle left-to-right), into the Front Housing then Install the iPhone 7° into the Front Housing so that the phone's camera aligns with the black rubber, lens baffle on the Camera Housing Lens. The perimeter edges of the iPhone 7°, along the top, bottom, left and right sides, should rest securely within the 10 grey silicone isolation bumpers located around the interior perimeter of the Front Housing.









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Installing the iPhone (cont.)

3. Close the hinged clear back cover until the main body o-ring seal is fully





4. Rotate the Cam Latch 180 degrees, Clockwise CW, to the CLOSED Position and verify that the Cam Latch Lock Button 'clicks' and 'pops' into the fully locked position. A secondary tactile and visual verification, that the Cam Latch is CLOSED & LOCKED, can be achieved by very gently attempting to rotate the Cam Latch, when it is positioned in the CLOSED & LOCKED position, with the Cam Latch Lock Button fully extended into the locking hole.

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5. Visually inspect the main body o-ring seal and ensure that you see even contact between the main body o-ring seal and the Housing around the full circumference of the Housing

Changing or Removing Lens Ports on the Housing



1. Remove the Lens Port by firmly holding the Housing in one hand and grasping the diamond knurled outside edge of the Lens Port with the other hand. Rotate the Lens CCW (counter clockwise) until the Lens Port separates from the Lens Mount on the Housing.

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- After detaching the Lens Port from the Housing place it down on a smooth flat surface with the rear end up to avoid scratching the lens surface.
- 3. With the Lens Port removed, the PRO Housing is no longer waterproof. NEVER use a PRO Housing near the water when a Lens Port is not installed on the Housing.

Changing or Removing Lens Ports on the Housing (cont.)



4. Visually inspect the Lens Port prior to re-installing it onto the Housing, Inspect for damage to the screw threads and the two o-ring seals on the Lens Port. These two o-ring seals must be free from any kind of contamination such as hair, sand, dust and dirt. There should be no deformation. hairline cracks, stretch marks, wear marks or cuts visible in the o-rings.

- 5. If any visible damage to either o-ring is discovered during inspection DO NOT USE. Replacement o-rings kits are available from Watershot. If any visible damage to the Lens Port threads is discovered DO NOT USE.
- 6. Lightly lubricate the two o-ring seals with a thin coat of silicone lubricant only when necessary. If the o-ring seals have a "shiny" appearance, there is no need to

Changing or Removing Lens Ports on the Housing (cont.)



- 7. Visually inspect the Lens Port mating surfaces on the Housing prior to installing the Lens Port. Inspect for damage to the screw threads and the mating surfaces where the Lens Port o-rings contact. These surfaces must be free from any kind of contamination such as hair, sand, dust and dirt. If any visible damage to the Lens Port threads or mating surfaces is discovered DO NOT USE
- 8. To re-install the Lens Port onto the PRO Housing, firmly hold the Housing in one hand and grasp the diamond knurled outside edge of the Lens Port with the other hand. Align the threads of the Lens Port with the threads on the Housing, Rotate the Lens Port CW (clockwise) until the Lens Port stops - DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN, DO NOT USE ANY TOOL TO TIGHTEN.
- 9. Repeat the Initial Waterproof Test Instructions prior to using the Housing.

Important Safety Instructions



- Read and follow the instructions in this manual.
- 2 Perform recommended test and checks
- Do not use the Housing beyond the rated depth rating 60m/195ft
- After each use the Housing should be closed shut, latched and soaked (20min in fresh water), micro fiber cloth dried, then air dried with the Housing open.
- Always follow installation and removal process per the manufacturers instructions.
- $Replace\ o\text{-ring}(s)\ that\ are\ deformed,\ exhibit\ hairline\ cracks,\ stretch\ marks,\ wear\ marks\ or\ cuts.$
- Apply o-ring lubricant sparingly and only when necessary, a light, thin film is all that is required.
- If cracks, deformation, or other damage is observed DO NOT USE.
- Keep away from heat sources.
- 10. Phone may overheat (and shut off) if installed in the Housing and exposed to
- 11. Contains small parts which may be a choking hazard. Not suitable for children under 3 years old
- 12. Watershot is not liable for damage to contents.
- 13. Desiccant strips are provided, use if lens fogging occurs (due to condensation within the Housing which may be caused by high relative humidity when loading your phone). Place the desiccant strip into the Housing (place pack flat in the front Housing between the ribs below the iPhone) and keep the Housing closed for at least 5 minutes before going into the water. Safety Instructions (Cont.)



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- 14. If there is a screen protector on your iPhone 7°, remove it. Screen Protectors may affect the operation between the Push Buttons on your Watershot Housing and the Touch Screen on the iPhone 76
- 15. Petroleum based products can have a damaging effect on the clear Polycarbonate Rear Housing which may lead to crazing or small crescent shaped cracks. When using your Watershot Housing avoid contact with any and all petroleum based products. This may also include sunscreens, lotions and cleaning agents. If you have any doubts, thoroughly wash and dry your hands before handling the Watershot Housing.
