The Mini Pannier is the result of countless hours of toil on every angle of this fabulous piece of luggage, from design to utility. So now that you finally find it beautifully perched on your table, let's get it where the bag rightfully belongs, your motorcycle.

WILL THIS BAG FIT MY BIKE

If you're wondering whether the bag will appropriately fit on your motorcycle, let us assure you that we've gone to great lengths in ensuring that the bag can be easily mounted on most motorcycles. The bags are best suited for motorcycles with an exposed frame at the rear end but can also be fitted if the frame is under the seat.

It has also be designed in a way so as to avoid contact with upswept exhausts incase your motorcycle has them.

The bag has two belts with buckles at the back that go around and secure the bag. The use of buckles ensures that it can not come off even at high speeds or nasty bumps.

Additionally there are two nylon straps to hold the bottom of the bag if you enjoy extra security.



WHATS IN THE PACKAGE

The Mini Pannier comes equipped as a fully functional motorcycle cum sling bag. As riders we have made a bag that we would love to use everyday. Here's what you will find in the package

- Mini Pannier Bag ; but of course :)
- Two Nylon Straps for additional safety
- Shoulder Strap
- A reusable cotton bag for packaging

If you own the Backpack Pannier, you may also additionally purchase the Backpack Mount that will combine the two bags to create a unique one of a kind combination.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

It is utmost important that you examine all safety concerns associated with using the Mini Pannier

- Loose straps may come in contact with parts of the motorcycle and cause serious injury or death to the riders.
- Take off the shoulder strap and keep it in the bag while riding
- No Part of the Bag or the mounts should come in contact with moving parts or excess heat.
- Always inspect all parts of the bag and the mounts before starting your ride
- Regularly inspect the bag and mounts for any wear and tear.

Replace the mounts if there is excessive wear and tear.

- Do not overload the bag. Keep the heaviest item at the bottom of the bag
- Get acquainted with riding with bag on your motorcycle.





MOUNTING THE MINI PANNIER ON THE MOTORCYCLE

- Thoroughly examine your motorcycle and determine which side you want to mount your Bag.
- Pass the leather straps at the back of the bag from under the frame and tightly buckle up both belts.
- You may want to additionally use the nylon straps to hold the bag from the bottom using the D rings provided.

MOUNTING THE MINI PANNIER ON THE BACKPACK PANNIER

If you own the Backpack Pannier, you may want to purchase the Backpack Mount as well. This allows the Mini Pannier to easily attach to the Backpack.

- Pass the bottom hooks of the mount via the leather loops at the bottom of the bag and clamp to the D rings of the Mini Pannier
- Pass the top dog hook of the mount through the leather bridge under the Handmade logo
- Clamp the dog hook to the buckle of the Backpack Pannier.



You should keep the following pointers in mind, while using the Mini Pannier

- **EXAMINE YOUR MOTORCYCLE:** Thoroughly inspect your motorcycle and ensure that your motorcycle is in good shape. You should do this even if you are not mounting the Mini Pannier
- **SECURE YOUR BAG:** Ensure that there are no loose ends hanging from the bag or the mounts that could come in contact with moving or hot parts of the motorcycle. Keep a check and ensure everything is secured in place every time you stop.
- **SHOULDER STRAP:** The shoulder strap should be used only when the bag is not mounted on the motorcycle. Please do not mount the bag with the shoulder strap attached.
- **KEEP IT AWAY FROM THE EXHAUST or HEAT:** The Mini Pannier is made of high grade leather and hence has a very good resistance to heat. However it is still good practice to maintain some distance between the bag and the exhausts.
- **LOAD:** Never overload your Mini Pannier beyond its capacity.
- **TEST RIDE:** Riding with some weight on one side of the motorcycle could take some time getting used to and hence you should take a few short rides before you head into the sunset.
- **PAINT DAMAGE:** In certain cases, the paint of the metal part that rubs with the bag might peel off. This is natural; however if you want to protect it, apply a black vinyl tape to that part before using your Bag.
