CLARISONIC FOOT BRUSH TO THE RELAUNCH OF CHOOSES HER TOP 10 PRODUCTS FOR A JANUARY REBOOT

New year sees a whole raft of new beauty and cosmetics launches, but here are the 10 products I'm most excited about for the coming months.

#### 1 CLARISONIC PEDI SONIC TRANSFORMATION SYSTEM, £175

Already well known for its sonic face-cleansing brushes, Clarisonic has turned its attention to feet. Yes, it plans to save our soles with a whole foot-smoothing system that includes two different brush heads (one for smoothing dry skin, one for wet and dry buffing) and comes with its own products. The Pedi-Buff scrub, for example, contains a sloughing formula of lactic acid, apricot seeds and a tri-fruit complex. Available now.

#### 2 DIOR CHEEK & LIP GLOW, £27

I get quite obsessed with new blushes and formulations, and this one by Dior is a new favourite that's already going everywhere with me. The formula adapts to any complexion to give it a natural rosy flush, so just dab it on for some instant perkifying. Available from Wednesday.

#### 3 POMMADE DIVINE, £20

Before it disappeared from the shelves in the 1980s, this multitasking balm was a stalwart of many a nursery, in production in one form or

another for almost 200 years. Now relaunched, the blend of benzoin, liquidambar, clove, cinnamon and nutmeg helps to soothe everything from cuts to sunburn, bites to bruises. While on holiday in Thailand recently, I tested its claim to help with mozzie bites. Normally I'm left with huge red welts, but a quick application of this on the bites and they healed without even becoming itchy. Now not only a must-have in my bathroom, but also in my ready-to-travel washbag. From cultbeauty.co.uk

#### 4 CHANEL HYDRA BEAUTY MICRO SERUM, £66

Chanel has harnessed new skincare technology to suspend super-moisturising micro-droplets of camellia in this serum. The droplets "break" when applied to the face to release a "wave" of moisture to the skin. I have been trying this since attending the launch a few months ago and my skin feels much more hydrated and less prone to night-time wrinkles. Available from Friday.

#### 5 ELECTIMUSS FRAGRANCE, £130

This cool new fragrance brand takes its inspiration from ancient Rome and its obsession with perfume. Electimus is launching with a Pure Perfume Series range of five scents, made from essential oils. My favourite, Saggita, a blend of champaca, citrus, apricot and musk, is winsomely

seductive, while Rhodante, with its blend of Bulgarian rose, lily, bergamot and tuberose, is powerfully feminine. Now available from Roullier White.

#### 6 MAYBELLINE LASH SENSATIONAL, £8

The mascara wars continue, and Maybelline is always one of the key brands in the frontline. Its recent launch boasts a brush with specially layered bristles to capture even the smallest of lashes as well as the longer ones. Plus, it gives a deep black shade thanks to a new liquid-ink formula that's low in wax.

#### 7 BURBERRY RAIN OR SHINE PALETTE, £45

This limited-edition highlighting and blush palette isn't exactly reinventing the wheel, but it is really pretty and highly coverable. With shades of pink azalea, bright coral, hydrangea pink and a nude, there's every colour you need for a quiet colour boost. The snag is it's also almost too pretty to actually use. Available now.

#### 8 MAC RUBY WOO LIP PENCIL, £12.50

You may well wonder why a lip liner in arguably Mac's most recognisable shade, Ruby Woo, doesn't already exist. However, it will soon be available

as part of the Pencilled In collection, which will also include liners in three more of the brand's bestselling lipstick shades. Snap them up while you can. Available from March 5; online from February 26.

#### 9 CLARINS INSTANT LIGHT LIP COMFORT OIL, £18

I suffer from dry lips all year round, and this nifty little product really moisturises them. Following in the proud tradition of Clarins treatment oils, this all-natural oil is more nourishing than a lip balm, lightweight and sinks into lips. Available in two shades: honey, for a natural look, and a tinted raspberry (available online only). You can also use lipstick on top. Available from February.

#### 10 LANCOME MIRACLE CUSHION, £30

Harnessing technology that's already a huge success in Asia, this compact lies somewhere between a foundation and a BB cream. It is applied with a pad, which gives a lightweight but transformative coverage. The cushionlike sponge that holds the product is full of mini "chambers" and bubbles of air, which ensure that just the right amount of product is delivered evenly each time. But, really, what you want to know is that it feels as though you're wearing nothing, looks as though you've just come back from holiday, and covers all your blotches. Available from February. ♦
