

# Lazy Girl's Hat

Yarn:	Tools/Notions:	Gauge:
<p><b>1 skein AdriaFil KnitCol (137 yards) plus 20 yards contrast DK or worsted</b></p>	<p><b>#5 and #6 16" circulars plus #6 DPNs (or magic loop)</b></p>	<p><b>5.5 sts = 1" in stockinette</b></p>
<p><b>Brim:</b> With #5 16" circular needles (or 32-40" circls if doing magic loop), cast on 120 stitches with brim color (any DK or worsted yarn with some "give" will work). Work in 2x2 rib until you get tired of it (about 1-2 inches).</p> <p><b>Body of Hat:</b> Change to #6 needles and KnitCol, and knit for 5-6 inches.</p> <p>Work decrease rounds (switching to DPNs as needed):            k10, k2 tog around            knit 1 round            k9, k2tog around            knit 1 round            k8, k2tog around</p> <p>From here, decrease every round:            k7, k2tog around            k6, k2tog around            k5, k2tog around            k4, k2tog around            k3, k2tog around            k2, k2 tog around            k1, k2 tog around            k2 tog around.</p> <p>With tapestry needle, run yarn through remaining stitches and cinch tight. Weave ends.</p>
