

Square Peg Cowl

Yarn:	Needles:	Gauge:
Kertzer Meadows, alpaca/wool/ acrylic, 66 yards, 2 skeins	#13 straight or circular, 3 1-inch straight inches	2.5 sts/inch, blocked
<p>Stitch Pattern: Row 1 (RS): Knit Row 2: (WS): P1, K1</p> <p>Directions: Cast on LOOSELY 25 sts.</p> <p>Work stitch pattern until piece measures 28 inches from beginning. Bind off LOOSELY.</p> <p>Finishing: This piece may be aggressively blocked with a steam iron and a thin cloth separating the piece from the iron. Block to finished measurements of 30 inches wide and 10 inches tall, opening up and evening out the stitch pattern as you go.</p>	<p>Sew buttons 7 inches, 10 inches and 13 inches from cast-on edge, centered vertically.</p> <p>To style, simply push your button/s through the fabric to get the cowl look that you want - asymmetrical, symmetrical or anything in between. Can also be worn as a shawlette.</p>	

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
