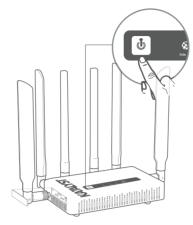
KADET 5G ROUTER

SETTING UP



When powered up, your Kadet router will broadcast both 2.4GHz and 5GHz Wi-Fi signal with the SSID: KAT-xxxx and KAT-xxxx-5G.

Hot plug for TF card and Nano-SIM card are not supported for this router.



After inserting cards, turn on the router by pressing the power button.

2 Connect via Wi-Fi

Connect to the Wi-Fi called KAT-xxxx or KAT-xxxx-5G, and then input the default Wi-Fi password which is the last 8 digits of the serial number and is also printed on the bottom label of the router.



Search the SSID and connect to it.

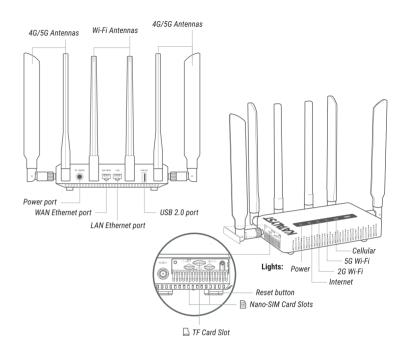

Repair/Reset

- Press and hold for 3 seconds, and then release to repair your network.
- Press and hold for 10 seconds, and then release to reset the router to factory settings. All user data will be cleared.

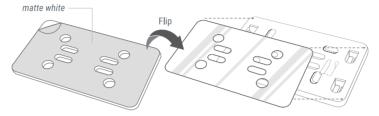
INSTALLATION

Adhesive Mount

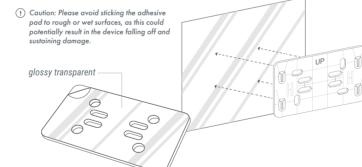


Peel off the matte white film and attach the adhesive pad to the wall mount. This will be a permanent application.

Tip: Before installing Kadet, we recommended speed-testing different locations to determine the best location to mount. (If installing in an interior location with multiple walls, you may get a better signal near a window.)



Peel off the **glossy transparent** film and then stick the adhesive pad onto a clean and dry glass surface.



Attach the router to the wall mount.



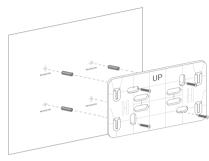


Maintain a minimum distance of 20 cm between the router and individuals while charging.

Screw Fixed Mount



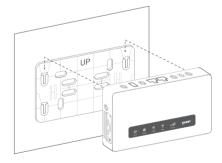
Align the wall mount to the wall. Secure 4 screws through the wall mount holes into the wall.

Attach the router to the wall mount.



If you need to remove or reposition the router, first remove the router from the mount and then slowly twist the mount with pressure. Once removed, the mount can be repositioned using the same installation instructions. The gel material can be rinsed if it is dirty and prevents proper adhesion to the mounting surface.
