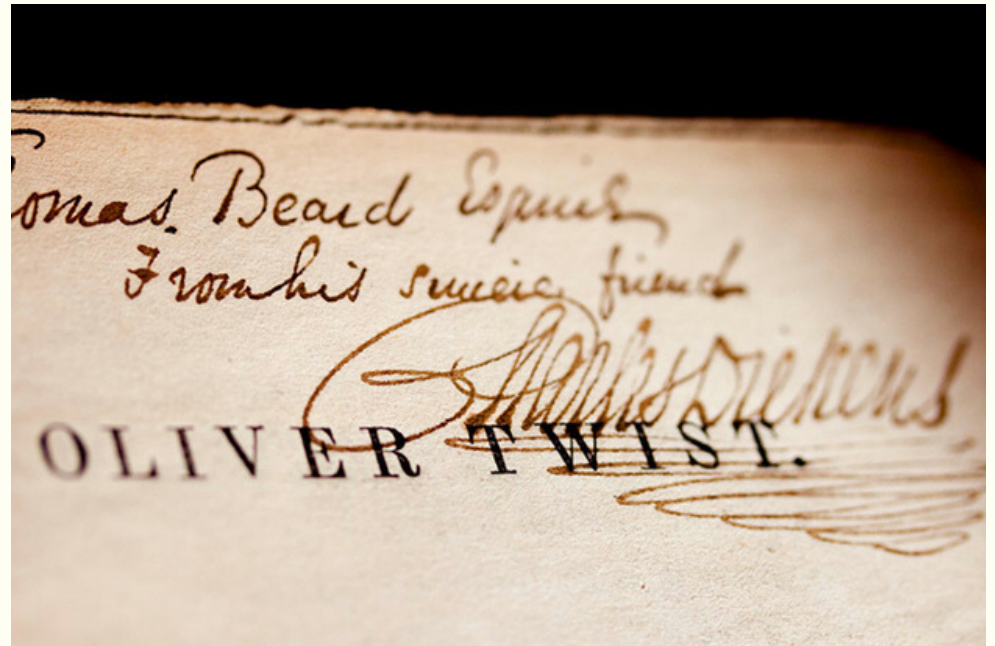

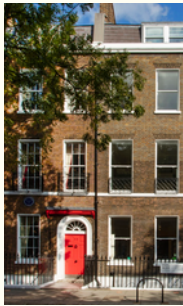

The historic house is made available to all drinks reception bookings, so as an additional unique feature, your guests will be able to explore the London home of Charles Dickens out of hours.

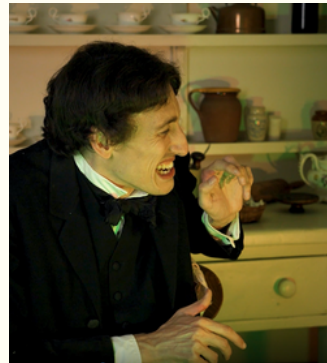
