CARE INSTRUCTIONS

For general care we recommend dusting with a clean, dry cloth, or wiping down with soft cloth wrung dry from plain water (leaving the surface dry after cleaning).

Solvents like nail polish remover can cause significant damage to your timber furniture. Do not use these products with timber as direct contact will require re-varnishing to repair. Another common enemy of timber is direct heat, for example, placing a saucepan on a timber table. This can burn or melt the finish.

Common stains like red wine, glue and sticky fingers can be removed with a damp cloth and should be attended to as quickly as possible to avoid the stain seeping in to the timber. Regular dusting will enhance the look and longevity of your item.

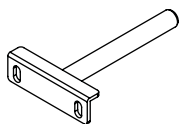

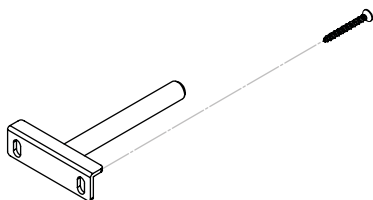

Locate bracket at desired height on wall. Make sure bracket is the right way up as shown.



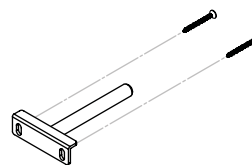

Fix the first screw in place.

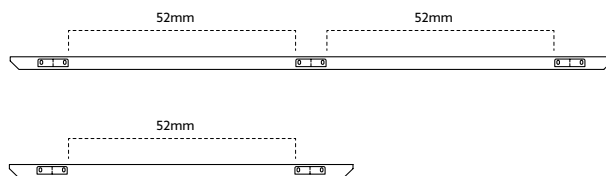
Use a spirit level to find level placement of next bracket before fixing subsequent screws in place.

For medium shelves, measure 52mm from the inner edge of your first bracket to the inner edge of your second bracket. Position accordingly.

For large shelves, the distance should be 52mm between each set of brackets.

Each bracket has movement horizontally and vertically so you can position the bracket in the right place for the shelf before locking the bracket in place with the plastic dial.

Slide shelf onto wall brackets and secure with set screws.
