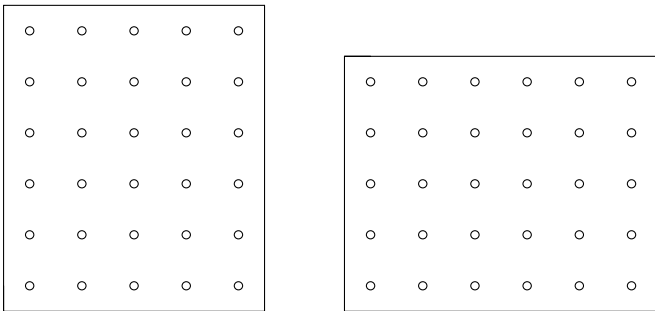

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

For general care we recommend dusting with a clean, dry cloth, or wiping down with soft cloth wrung dry from plain water (leaving the surface dry after cleaning).

Solvents like nail polish remover can cause significant damage to your timber furniture. Do not use these products with timber as direct contact will require re-varnishing to repair. Another common enemy of timber is direct heat, for example, placing a saucepan on a timber table. This can burn or melt the finish.

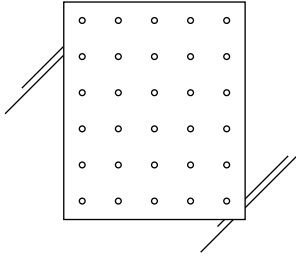
Common stains like red wine, glue and sticky fingers can be removed with a damp cloth and should be attended to as quickly as possible to avoid the stain seeping in to the timber. Regular dusting will enhance the look and longevity of your item.

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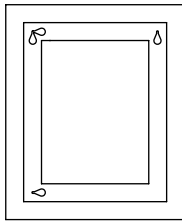
01

Hold up the Peggy and position it where you want it on the wall.



02

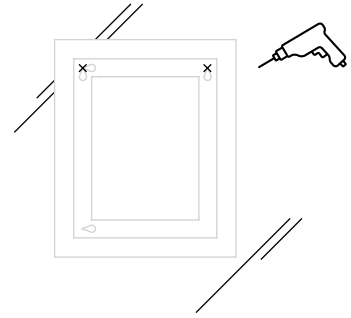
Mark where you want the pegboard to hang. On the wall side of the cabinet, you will find two small tear-drop shapes - these will be used to hang your pegboard.

Measure the top of the hole on the back (which will be where the screw fixes) of the pegboard to the top of your desired placement so you know where to put the screws into the wall that will hold Peggy in place. Mark these positions on the wall as well as the distance between the 2 shapes.

Once you have marked the wall and are happy with the position of the cabinet, you are ready to fix it in place!



04

Drill into the wall to create a small opening for the plug.

05

Tap the plug in with a hammer.

06

Then fit the screw to a power screwdriver, set to LOW and place at the fastening position.

07

Push sharply to create a turning point.

08

Drive the screw home.

Hang your Peggy, add your shelves, put something cute on it. Then, step back and admire your handy work!

PLEASE NOTE

The dowels may feel a bit tight initially, but they will fit. We have made them tight to ensure there is minimal movement and they hold firm. Twist the dowels into place with a firm hand and tap in the rest of the way using a mallet.

The fixings you may need depend on the type of wall you have. We have provided multi-purpose screws, however you may also need plugs to hold them in place.

If you are unsure about what you need, please check with your local hardware store or handy friend.
