

# Trifecta Connection Kit – How to install

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## Minimum Requirements

2 Trifectas

4 Connectors “2 connectors for each side when a Trifecta is laid open and flat”

Install time varies due to the dexterity and experience with the connectors.

1. Lay out two unzipped and open Trifectas “first green side down”



2. Second Trifecta “green side up” over the first Trifecta



3. Get out your Trifecta Connectors you should have four.
  - a. The reason for four connectors is you need to use one connector as a stop to prevent the zipper from unzipping itself.
  - b. There is a red slide pull and a green slide pull side. On the green side you will have a thumb screw.
  - c. The way the slide is installed matters for the V2 Trifecta with the water resistant zippers. If done with all connectors with the green side out the zipper will work but it will have a slight ridge in the center where they meet and not close as well. The red pull should be out or thumb screw facing inside.
  - d. In these instructions I put the green side out for the stops or bottom of the Trifecta. This makes it easier to install the stops as I do not plan on moving the green slides.

4. Try to center the center both Trifectas where the four black zipper pulls meet.
5. Next take one of your connectors, loosen the thumb screw so there is a slight gap between the connector slide and slide it onto one of the zippers. Note the direction of the flat side of the pull it's facing out or in this case to the right.
6. Once you have that installed tighten the thumb screw "don't overly tighten" but make it snug.
7. Repeat on the left side of center flat side facing out.





8. Once you have both STOPS in place proceed to the next step



9. The next step is going to be installing the second slide on the right side of center. We will have the red side out or the thumb screw in.
  - a. Move four to five inches down from the green stop slide, install thumb screw in and flat side pointing in towards the other flat side on the stop, tighten enough that it doesn't fall off and slide back to the green pull.
  - b. Now make sure the zipper is flat "no kinks"
10. Now tighten snugly then back off the thumb screw a quarter to half turn. You don't want this overly tight as it won't slide well
11. Test the slide, it should bring the teeth together and seal the zipper
12. Repeat on the left side.





13. Final product should look like this “this is the bottom of the Trifecta or what I call the bottom”





14. Now we're going to take the Red slide and close the zippers, you might have a little extra zipper at the top of the Trifecta after you fully zip, this is due to a slight miss alignment at the bottom or where the green STOPS were placed or a slight difference in the Trifectas themselves



Inside the XXL Trifecta zipped up. Note there will be a slight hole at the bottom and top but very small as you can see in the pictures.
