

STEP 1

FILL

Fill your All Season Pool by placing the hose in your filter skimmer located on either side.

Water must be 85°F before proceeding to step 2.

Drain and refill your All Season Pool water yearly (or as needed).

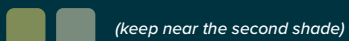


STEP 2

BALANCE WATER

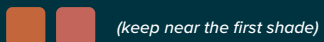
Test your water for pH and total alkalinity using the test strips provided. Adjust your water accordingly and retest.

Alkalinity 100 - 120ppm



(keep near the second shade)

pH 7.2 - 7.5



(keep near the first shade)

Make sure pump 1 is running on high speed when adding chemicals. Run all pumps and leave the cover open for 20 minutes after adding chemicals

Add no more than 12 capfuls of pH Down or Alka Up in a 20 minute period

• Raise alkalinity if required using Jacuzzi® Alka Up

1 tablespoon of Alka Up per 1,000L will raise alkalinity approximately 10ppm

• Lower alkalinity if required using Jacuzzi® pH Down

1 tablespoon of pH down per 1,000L will lower alkalinity approximately 10ppm

• Lower pH if required using Jacuzzi® pH Down.

Add 6 capfuls of Jacuzzi® pH down, retest and repeat as necessary.

• Raise pH if required using Jacuzzi® pH Up.

Add 6 capfuls of Jacuzzi® pH Up, retest and repeat as necessary.

STEP 3

SHOCK & CHLORINE

Add 6 capfuls of Jacuzzi® Spa Shock and run all pumps on high speed for 20 minutes with the cover open.

Add 1 tablespoon of Jacuzzi® Chlorine Granules per 1,000L of water and run all pumps on high speed for 20 minutes with the cover open.

Attach a Zorbie® near the filter. Be sure to never squeeze your Zorbie®.

STEP 4

CONDITION WATER

Once the water is balanced and your All Season Pool is 85°F or hotter, pour the entire bottle of Spa Solution® around the All Season Pool and run all pumps on high speed for 20 minutes with the cover open.

STEP 5

COPPER

Press the button under the blue light at the end of your All-Season Pool every 3 days until copper levels reach 0.2-0.4ppm. This activates the large dose mode for 72 hours. Test your copper every two weeks.

To cancel a large dose mode press and hold the button for 5-seconds (the light will stop flashing/pushing)

AFTER EACH USE

TURN AIR VALVES OFF

- Add ½ cap of Jacuzzi® Spa Shock per person (per 20 minutes) and run all pumps on high speed for 20 minutes with the All Season Pool cover open.
- Test at least twice weekly to ensure chlorine always remains at 3ppm.
- It may be necessary to add chlorine after using the All Season Pool in order to maintain 3ppm. With frequent testing you can significantly decrease the amount of chlorine you use.

WEEKLY

1. Thoroughly rinse the filters with a Filter Flosser® to remove debris.
2. Test and balance alkalinity and pH.
3. Use 6 capfuls of Jacuzzi® Spa Shock. Run pump 1 on high speed for 20 minutes with the cover open. Add 2 tablespoons of Jacuzzi® Chlorine Granules if chlorine is below 3ppm and run pump 1 on high speed for 20 minutes with the cover open. Retest and adjust as needed.

BI-WEEKLY

- Test your copper levels using copper test strips. Adjust ionizer to maintain 0.2 - 0.4ppm or turn the system on and off by pressing and holding the button for 10+ seconds until the blue light turns on/off.

MONTHLY

- Thoroughly clean your filters using Jacuzzi® Cartridge Cleaner or Aqua Magic® and rinse them with water using a Filter Flosser®.
- Replace Zorbie® every other month.

ONCE A YEAR

- If applicable, rotate your Rollaway® Cover 180° Degrees.
- Drain and refill your All Season Pool annually (or twice annually) as required.
- Replace your filters.

EVERY 2 YEARS

- Have a Jacuzzi Ontario technician inspect your ClearBlue™ Mineral System.

MAINTENANCE TIPS

Cloudy Water

- Test and balance alkalinity and pH. After balancing water, add 6 capfuls of Jacuzzi® Spa Shock and all run pumps for 20 minutes with the cover open. Add 2 tablespoons of Jacuzzi® Chlorine Granules per 1,000L of water and run all pumps for 20 minutes with the cover open. Retest water for chlorine in 6-8 hours and repeat if chlorine reading is 1ppm or less.
- Add 12 capfuls of Jacuzzi® Spa Clear and run all pumps for 20 minutes.
- Rinse filters daily or twice daily until water is clear.

Blue Line

A blue/green line is a result of too much copper. You can adjust the ionizer inside the cabinet or turn the system off (by pressing and holding the button until the blue light turns off). The blue/green line can be removed safely with a Mr. Clean Magic Eraser. The blue line will reoccur until copper levels return to normal.

Remember, if you do turn off your system be sure to check the copper every 2 weeks and turn the system back on when copper reaches 0.2ppm (by pressing and holding the button until the light turns back on).
