

- 1. Vist UPS.com and click "Ship" on the Quick Start menu.
- 2. Enter your shipping details. You will ship your parcel to:

3. Continue on to enter your package details. Enter weight, dimensions, and a **Declared Value for the full retail value of your knife.** The declared value will ensure your package is fully insured, should something happen during transit.*

- 2. Enter your shipping details. You will ship your parcel to:

- 3. Enter package details. You may ship Flat Rate or use your own package (packages with one knife are about 2 lbs).
- 4. Enter a Package Value for the full retail value of your knife (Figure 1.1). The declared value will ensure your package is fully insured, should something happen during transit.*
- 4. Choose a service type, pay, print, and ship!


