

GUINIGI PROSECCO ROSÉ

The Guigini winery is named after the Guinigi tower, one of the few historical towers to still stand tall in Northern, Italy. The grapes for their wines are sourced and produced from premium Italian provinces and are crafted to be bold, vibrant, and appealing.



Region: Treviso DOC, Veneto, Italy

Notes: Bright and delicate, this Italian rosé shines with a soft hue of pink mother of pearl among lasting and fine bubbles. Aromas are driven by fruit, with notes of apple, white peach, citrus, and wild strawberries balanced against floral notes of peach blossoms. The mouthfeel is refreshing with a high level of acidity cleansing the palate between each new sip.

Alcohol by Volume: 11.5%

Best Served: 40-50°F

Grapes: Glera and Pinot Noir



Pairings: This sparkling rosé is best served with lighter dishes such as a Caprese salad, creamy vegetable risotto, fresh seafood, or a platter of sushi.
