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CHENIN BLANC

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Lievland, directly translated, means "love land" and there are few who come to this farm that isn't charmed by its bucolic beauty. Twenty years ago, Lievland was considered one of South Africa's top estates. José Conde and Tyrrel Myburgh, partners in MAN Family Wines, purchased the farm in late 2017 with the goal of resurrecting it to its former glory. Today, the winery produces a range of three wines: Pinotage, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Chenin Blanc!

Region: Western Cape, South Africa **Notes**: Made from old vines ranging between 38 and 45 years old, this wine has a light straw color with a golden hue, showing notes of white peach, citrus and pineapple on the nose. The mouthfeel is rich and ripe and is coupled with vibrant acidity.
