- **1A.** Attach Left & Right Base Frames (A & B) to Back Base Frame (C) using:
  - 4 (#2) M16x110mm Hex Head Bolt
  - 8 (#3) M16 Regular O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#5) M16 Nylon Lock Nut
- **1B.** Attach Left & Right Base Frames (A & B) to Logo Plate (D) using:
  - 4 (#1) M16x100mm Hex Head Bolt
  - 8 (#3) M16 Regular O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#5) M16 Nylon Lock Nut





# **STEP 2**

# Be careful to assemble all components in the sequence they are presented.


#### NOTE:

Finger tighten all hardware first in this step. Wrench tighten ALL hardware at the end of STEP 2C. Some components may be pre-assembled. Nylon lock nuts will not fully screw onto bolts, they must be wrench tighten to fully go on.


- **2A.** Attach Upright **(E)**, Left Base Frames **(A)** and Steel Plates **(F)** together using:
  - 4 (#2) M16x110mm Hex Head Bolt
  - 8 (#3) M16 Regular O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#5) M16 Nylon Lock Nut
- **2B.** Attach Upright **(E)**, Right Base Frames **(B)** and Steel Plates **(F)** together using:
  - 4 (#2) M16x110mm Hex Head Bolt
  - 8 (#3) M16 Regular O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#5) M16 Nylon Lock Nut
- 2C. Attach Chin Up Bar (G) to uprights (E) using:
  - 4 (#2) M16x110mm Hex Head Bolt
  - 4 (#3) M16 Regular O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#4) M16 Large O.D. Washer
  - 4 (#5) M16 Nylon Lock Nut

#### NOTE:

- 1) Please refer to the drawing for the correct bolt hole locations. The bolt holes are the 12th and 15th holes from the front of the Base Frame.
- 2) SECURELY anchor the machine to the floor using the anchor holes provided. Please consult a professional contractor for the actual anchoring of the machine.
