

We recommend 3M FastBond Contact Adhesive 30NF Neutral (Meets ASTM E84 Class A requirements) (Greenguard certified) or Dap Weldwood Low Odor Contact Cement Note: The Peel and Stick method is not recommended for all Luxe & Supermatte patterns. Current & Facet can have a slight curl to the panel and do not work well with the tape.

1 PREPARATION




Install over primered drywall or plywood. Surface must be clean, smooth, dry, free of waxes and existing adhesive, dirt, dust, grease, oil, paint curing compound or sealers. Cannot be used over chemically cleaned substrates.

Panels should acclimate for a minimum of 48 hours prior to installation.

2 PLANNING


STICK 1/2" TAPE (SEMI-PERMANENT)



Will your install be wall-to-wall, a floating design, a strip of panels, etc? Plan before beginning and lay the panels out on the floor or sketch it out.


Use a level to mark straight lines on the wall. Allow cut panels to fall in more inconspicuous areas like corners and the bottom of a wall. If working from the center out, all panel edges may need to be cut. Plan your design well to ensure desired results are what you expect. Remember, measure twice and cut once.

3 SEMI-PERMANENT ADHESIVE



If choosing to install using Inhabit's Peel and Stick 1/2" Tape, apply the tape to the perimeter of each panel as well as strips across the panel on the touchpoint areas. Each corner should be covered. Press firmly along each strip. Peel backing off and adhere to the surface.

3 PERMANENT ADHESIVE




Installing with contact cement, follow manufacturer's recommendations on applying to both the wall and the panel and dry times prior to adhering to the wall. A second coat may be required.

TIPS FOR CUTTING PANELS

Wall Flats can be cut with power tools designed for finishing work (exp: 80 tooth blade for fine cutting or melamine cutting). Follow manufacturer's suggestions for equipment use and safety.


4 INSTALLATION



FINAL PRESSURE (Both Methods)

Once in place, secure using a **pressure roller** around the perimeter of the panel and other touchpoints to lock in place. When all the panels are installed, roll the entire flat surface to achieve a full bond. After rolled re-positioning is not possible.
