

ORGANIC CHILI PEPPER GROW KIT INSTRUCTIONS


mason jar planter & potting mix

organic chili pepper seeds

organic fertilizer spikes

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:







tap water

PLANTING

Remove planter lid and add 1/2 cup of water to the soil. Sprinkle 6-8 seeds and push each 1/4" into soil. Place planter in sunny window [8+ hours of direct sunlight] or under a grow light.





GERMINATION

Seeds will germinate in 7-10 days. To ensure germination, the top 2" of soil must be kept consistently moist during this period. Add water each time the soil begins to dry.



TIP: Place your lid on top of your planter to increase humidity and aid in germination.

WATERING

Water your chili pepper plant regularly, watching through your mason jar for soil to become mostly dry between waterings. Your peppers will need less water in early stages of growth, and more as it matures.



TIP: These chili peppers like it warm! They're happiest in a warm room with lots of direct sunshine or under a grow light.

THINNING

After germination, use your thumb and forefinger to remove all but the 3 strongest seedlings. After those seedlings reach ~3" tall, remove all but the strongest.



FLOWERING & FRUITING

When flowers appear (~6-7 weeks), push one fertilizer spike into the soil, away from stems and roots. When flowers open, tap the base of the plant for 30 seconds to help with pollination. When small peppers appear, add the second fertilizer spike.
